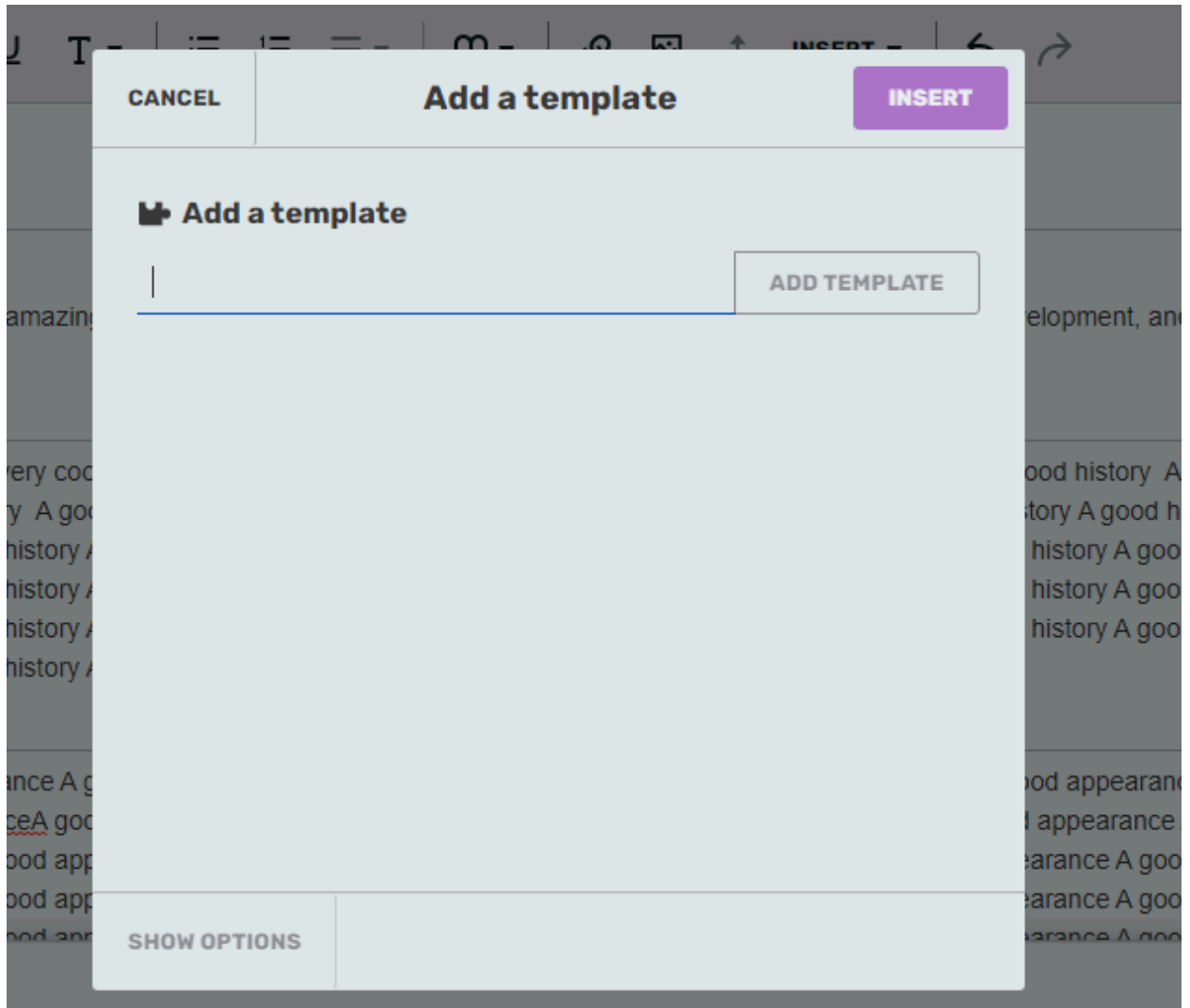

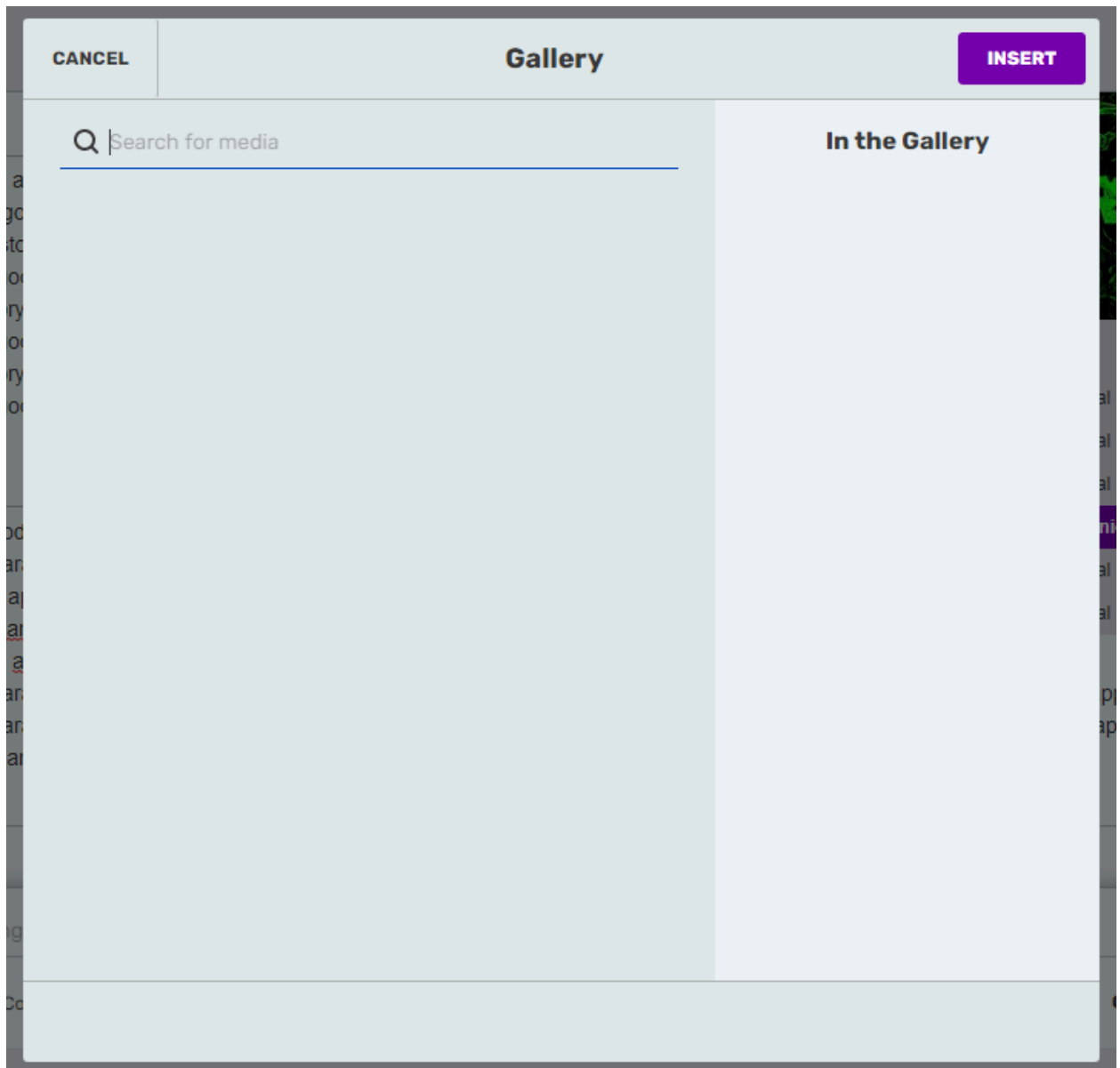

4. You also need to input the infobox. You can do this by typing “{{” at the top of the page and searching the template you are using.

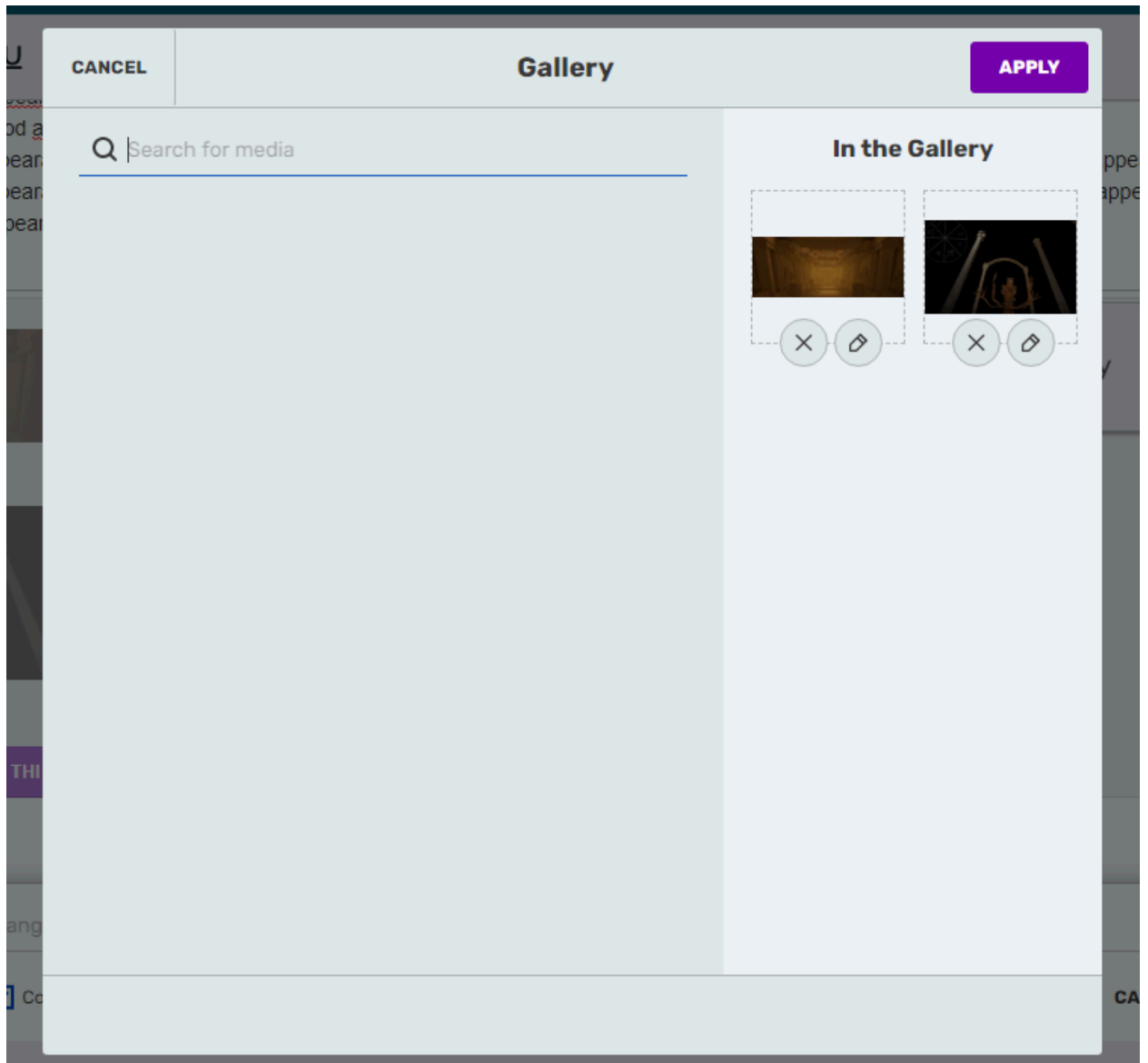


5. Then add the information into the infobox and click "Insert."

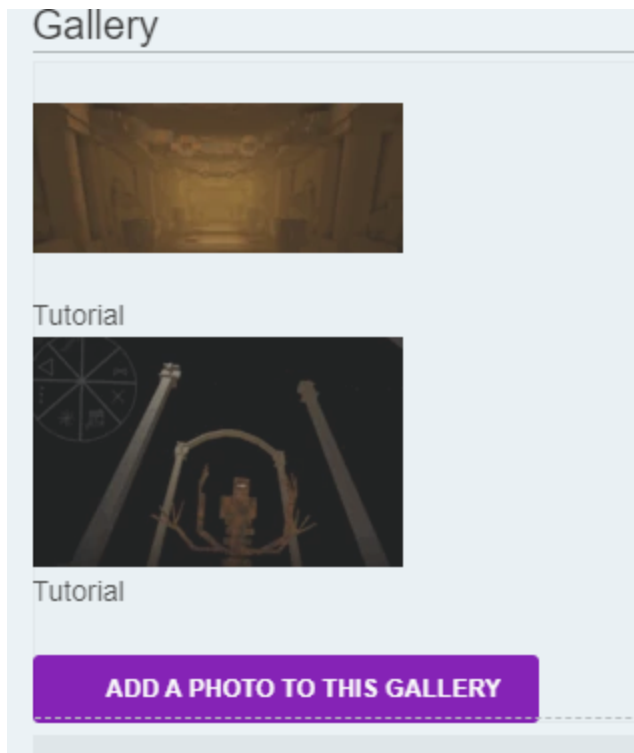
8. To do the gallery, you must type "<gallery" and you can search the images you want to add.



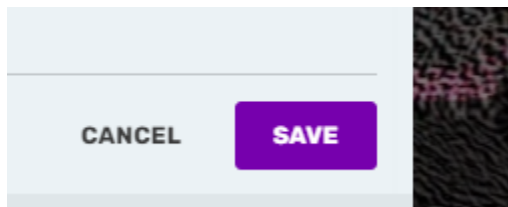
9. Once you pick the image, you can then give the image a caption. You can then add more images if needed. Once you are done click "Insert."

11. Click the "Save" button to post the page



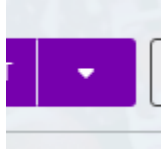
Editing Pages

1. To edit a page, you can find an edit button on the top right of a page.

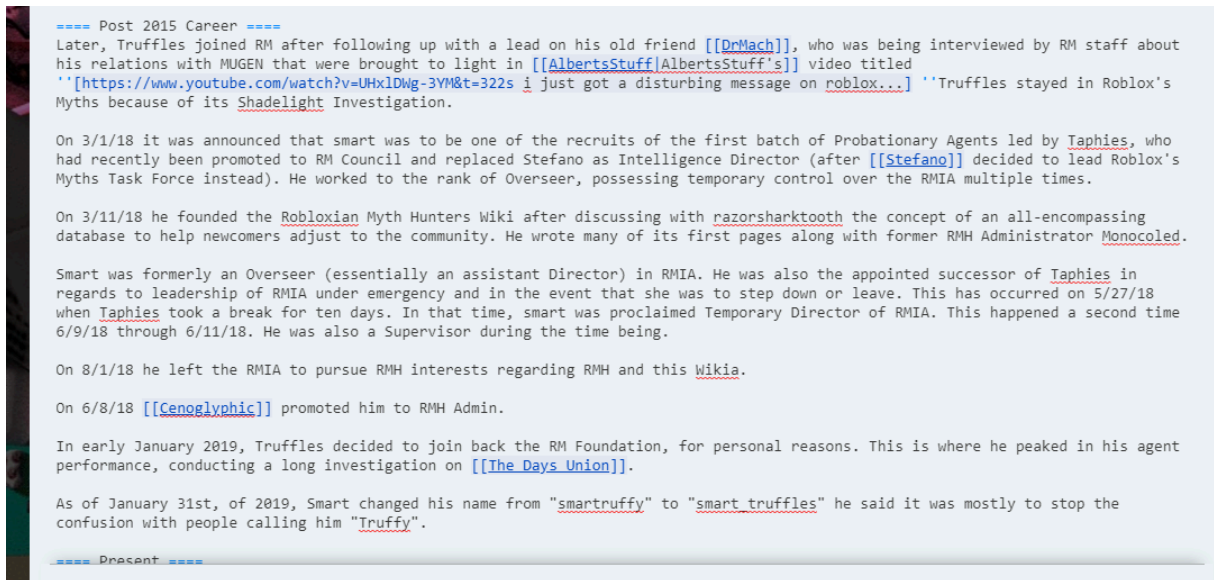


2. You can then edit the page and follow most of the steps under creating a page

3. There is also something called “Edit source” this is editing the page by it’s code. You can edit the page’s source by hovering your mouse over the arrow next to the edit button, and click “Edit source.”
