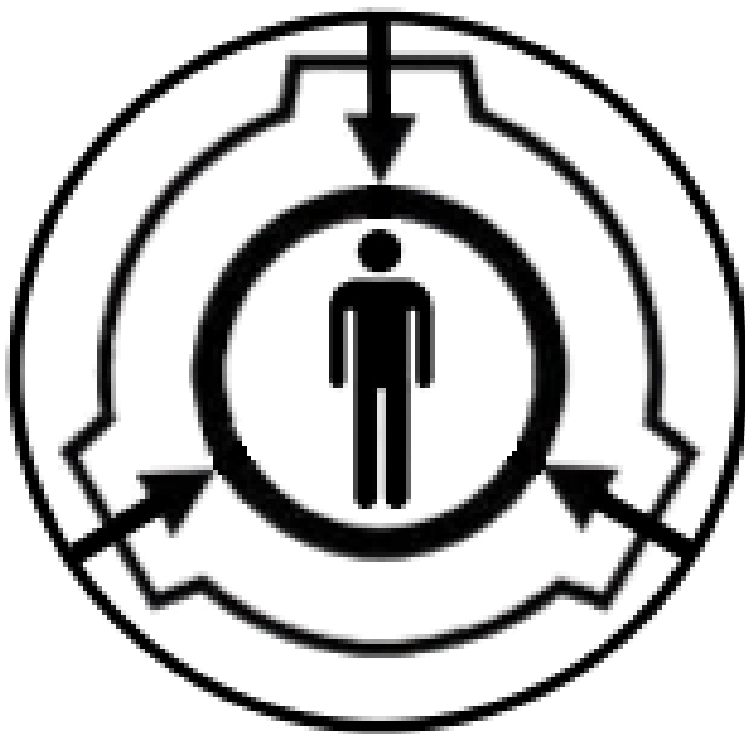

Séan O'Shea is presently a member of Site-65's Ethics Committee, prior to this assignment he was the Commander of Mobile Task Force Epsilon-11 "Nine-Tailed Fox".

O'Shea is commonly referred to around the site as "RedMann", a nickname given in his very early days in E-11 that has stuck ever since. See noted incident #3 for further details.

O'Shea has served the foundation for roughly [REDACTED] years. He was recruited to MTF E-11 from the Irish navy, see recruitment report and noted incident #1 for further details.

Noteworthy Incidents

Incident # 1

Nature Of incident: Combative

Date of Incident: 30/07/20██

Brief: Exposed to SCP-4217 while serving in the Irish Navy.

On the 30th of July 20██, the Irish Navy vessel Lé William Butler Yeats came under the attack of SCP-4217. At the time O'Shea was in service as a Lieutenant, and was present aboard when SCP-4217 used its guns to fire upon the ship. An unnamed NCO partially determined the true nature of the battleship and insisted to Lt. O'Shea to fire below the water line.

O'Shea ordered a salvo of rockets to fire below the waterline. This was a successful attack which was followed up with a second barrage. SCP-4127 retreated at full speed. The Lé William Butler Yeats was recalled. Upon redocking at Cork Harbour to recuperate, all officers of the ship were reassigned to new posts or inducted into new divisions.

O'Shea was merited, but reassigned to the Army Ranger Wing.



Incident # 2

Nature of Incident:Recruitment

Date of Incident: 28/09/20██

Brief: Séan O'Shea is recruited to the foundation, and inducted into MTF E-11

O'Shea, now recruited into the Army Ranger Wing of the Irish Army, was chief of a subdivision. This subdivision were specialized military police, known as "MP 1". Though their operations are classified, MP 1 fight corruption and double agents in the Irish army.

On the 28th of September 20██, O'Shea is recruited into the foundation. Recruitment transferred O'Shea into Mobile Task Force Epsilon-11. Service begins the following week.

Incident # 3

Nature of Incident:Combative

Date of Incident: 22/01/20██

Brief: Séan O'Shea is involved in an incident during a containment breach that results in his Codename.

SPC O'Shea, SGT Argyle and CSG Wilson are responding to an unknown containment breach in the eastern wing of sector Hotel within the heavy containment zone. Along the hallway that leads to SCP-106's containment chamber.



As the three approach they hear sounds coming from within the chamber, as they approach they make a confirmation. Two instances of SCP-939 are present and leave the chamber, approaching the MTF. The three remain quiet and still to allow the instances to pass. While the instances pass SGT Argyle, his radio signals off, the two instances turn in sync and lay waste. While Argyle struggles, Wilson attempts to run past to make a run for the nitroglycerin dropped by Argyle. But the noise alerts the instances, one of them moves in and bites Wilson in the knee.

While his comrades are struggling on the ground, O'Shea attempted to reach for the nitroglycerin while shuffling past the instances laying feast to his allies. Finally he grabbed the bomb, but he nudged off one of the instances. The 939 wacked O'Shea to the side. In a split second without hesitation detonated the nitroglycerin.

The hallway erupted in flames and smoke, all units and 939s where enveloped in a smog.

When reinforcements arrived they found only a mangled body, no SGT Argyle or CSG Wilson, a lone unit and no 939s. The survivor was drenched in blood, his own, his comrades, and that of SCP-939. They couldn't identify the body. And since no one knew the new guy they just called "The Red Man".

By the time he had made a recovery he wasn't welcomed back with a "Séan" or an "O'Shea". Everyone knew him as "Red Man", eventually he accepted it and even began to own it.



Incident # 4

Nature of Incident:Promotion

Date of Incident: 18/03/20██

Brief: Séan O'Shea is Promoted to Lieutenant within Epsilon-11

CSG O'Shea, along with two others, are officially promoted to LT by LTCOM "Mirage". They begin their trial week immediately and take to the job with ease.

The evening of their ceremony, LT O'Shea is stopped by a CPL, Jessie "Chad". "Chad" and "RedMann" have a brief discussion but go about their day.

Incident #5

Nature of Incident:Hearing

Date of Incident: 26/03/20██

Brief: Epsilon-11 CO Team is struck and warned by the Site Director

LT "RedMann", LT "Crew", LT Moon, CPT Nuts and COM "Banshee" attend a hearing under Site Administration. SA is displeased with the state and management of Epsilon-11 and issues strikes to all members of the CO team and a deadline to improve.

LT "RedMann" hadn't even been assigned a regimental duty. However this would not prevent an intimidation to grow within



him, he became somewhat nervous and frightened of SA and the power they held.

Incident #6

Nature of Incident: Removal

Date of Incident: 1/04/20██

Brief: Epsilon-11 COM "Banshee" is removed.
"Bavarian" is appointed.

"RedMann" is seated at his desk in the later hours of the evening. He is approached by his friend CPT "Bavarian".

Good Evening Alex, late one is it?

Have you heard? Or seen? I suppose...

No?

Check your emails.

O'Shea turns back to open his emails, while he does, Alex drops a Commander rank patch on his desk

What's this?

Read.



"Dear Epsilon-11 CO team, your Commander has been removed as a follow up to the hearing held..."

Shit.

Incident #7

Nature of Incident: Promotion

Date of Incident: 8/04/2000

Brief: O'Shea is appointed an E-11 Major and is ordered a cease and desist.

Another Saturday, another meeting, though O'Shea did know there would be a Captain promotion today he wasn't sure who it would be. He figured Moon but couldn't be sure.

Nonetheless expectations weren't exactly high, until their new COM "Bavarian" gave his first address as Commander.

He called out the enlisted promotions, then the NCOs and finally got to the Lieutenants. He called out that LT "Crew" would be taking on the role of captain. O'Shea figured it wouldn't be his choice but that falls down to Alex. However Alex followed up with a "but that's not all".

LT "RedMann" and LT Moon were both to be promoted to the rank of Major.



Later that evening, now MAJ "RedMann" had a breeze through his emails. But something new had popped up. Straight from the Ethics Chairman, "Eidolon". It was a cease and desist due to his new Thaumalogist policy. Though he had cleared it through a Site Manager. Nonetheless it developed his resolve and overall caution towards site command and administration.

And unfortunately, this was a very poor first interaction with the Ethics Committee.

Incident #8

Nature of Incident: Promotion

Date of Incident: 22/04/20███

Brief: O'Shea is appointed as the E-11 LTCOM.

Once more, a standard meeting. Though this time O'Shea was on leave, and rather annoyingly he was asked to tune in video audio connection.

He listened and figured that it had been a couple of days since "Mirage" had gone on his reassignment to Africa and left the LTCOM spot vacant.

The audio quality was atrocious, but very vaguely he could hear the applause as he was just instated as the next LTCOM of E-11.



Incident #9

Nature of Incident: Promotion

Date of Incident: 14/07/20██

Brief: O'Shea is appointed as the E-11 COM.

Years and years of slaving away. Though he enjoyed the work, he wouldn't trade it for anything, it was beginning to take its toll. On leave once more he left the hands of the regiment confidently in his Majors. Alex had stepped down to Major one two weeks ago, and SA hadn't appointed a new COM yet so there wasn't much that could be done.

Finally the comms link came through. "Effective immediately, LTCOM "RedMann" is appointed as the new Commander of E-11". Ahh bliss, he thought.

Incident #10

Nature of Incident: Kidnapping

Date of Incident: 1/10/20██

Brief: O'Shea is kidnapped and brainwashed by the Chaos Insurgency.

O'Shea had only been taking a Sergeant out for a driving exam, he hadn't driven on surface in months. The humvee pulled in at the Pinewood gas station for a refill. While he was doing so his Sergeant stepped out. Before he noticed a gun was to his head,



he was restrained and stripped of tech and weapons and dragged off into the snow.

He was in the CI's base for only a few minutes. Class F amnestics flooded his veins, he forgot everything. His early days, to his time in E-11. But they where smart, they rebuilt him. They put him back inside, and ultimately, he served the insurgency, he fed them information and knowledge. He even turned a blind eye during raids and infiltrations.

He had been killed, and a puppet put in his place.

Incident #11

Nature of Incident: Combative

Date of Incident: 26/10/20███

Brief: O'Shea is discovered and pursued by ISD. Thus starting an E-11/ISD Skirmish

An Ambassador approached O'Shea outside his bunks. He had been called to floor 3, O'Shea had been found out, ISD where coming.

O'Shea hid and ordered his COs out of the heavy containment zone. He had them brainwashed too, he had built an army but they didn't know about them.



He ordered E-11 to engage ISD on sight if in HCZ. Gunshots rang out but Alpha-1 got the jump on him. He was dragged out and taken to floor 3.

When he got there he was stood before ISD while site command was on route. He and two of his COs, CPT "Crumpet" and CPT "Kree". The room was silent. He was handed a text to speech device for communication. He bickered with ISD and refused to call off the attacks. They threatened to kill his COs, but as they did, the Ambassador emerged and killed all the ISD in the blink of an eye.
