LESEN

-Idee 1: Read a German-language magazine. A bunch of magazines have free online subscriptions right now at <https://aktion.grunerundjahr.de/deutschland-bleibt-zuhause>. Scroll down, click on a topic, and then click on a magazine to get started. Other good magazines online are: <http://detektor.fm/themen> or <http://www.brigitte.de/>. They often have podcasts and videos to watch too.

-Idee 2: Read news in German. (www.spiegel.de, www.zeit.de, www.ard.de, usw.)

-Idee 3: Read a German book!

-Idee 4: Read on any topic that interests you online. (www.wikipedia.de has lots, but google searching in German will bring up tons of results)

-Idee 1: Watch German news videos from any German news sources or try this one that is for kids/teens and may be easier to understand: <https://www.zdf.de/kinder/logo>

-Idee 2: Watch an episode of German TV from www.ZDF.de or a streaming service. Since German TV is uncensored, you might want to stick to categories Kindersendungen

(<http://www.kindernetz.de/sendungen>), Sport, Nachrichten, or Wissen. Netflix shows and movies are ok too, but beware of inappropriate content!!

-Idee 3: Watch some German YouTubers on topics you're interested in. Search topics in German to find German-language videos (ex: Autos, Kosmetik, Mode, Fußball, Videospiele, usw.).

-Idee 4: Watch Nico's Weg - a series kind of like Jojo, but about a guy named Nico who moves to Germany. The A1 and A2 videos are more for German 1-3, and the B1 videos are German 4-5 level. Scroll to B1 and start watching!
