Direct Admission Candidates - Selection method: Profile assessment - "Applicants must have graduated or received a graduation recognition decision for a bachelor's degree (or equivalent or higher) in a relevant major for direct admission and possess foreign language proficiency as stipulated in Clause 1, Article 8 of Decision No. 21/QĐ-DHQQ dated January 6, 2023, amending and supplementing several articles of the Master's and Doctoral Admission Regulations issued with Decision No. 113/QĐ-DHQQ dated February 4, 2021, by the President of Vietnam National University Ho Chi Minh City, including one of the following candidates:" + Holders of a full-time bachelor's degree with 'Excellent' classification and a cumulative GPA of 8.0 or higher (on a 10-point scale); + Holders of a full-time bachelor's degree who graduated as the valedictorian of their major; + "Holders of a bachelor's degree who have won first, second, or third prizes in Student Olympic competitions (Student Research Awards from the Ministry of

Candidates Exempted from Foreign Language Examination - Selection method: Profile assessment and interview by a professional subcommittee. - "Applicants must have graduated or received a graduation recognition decision for a bachelor's degree (or equivalent or higher) in a relevant major; for the research-oriented track, a 'Good' graduation classification or higher is required, or scientific publications related to the field of study;" - Applicants participating in the articulated bachelor's to master's program of the University of Economics and Law; Foreign applicants who have graduated with a bachelor's degree in a relevant major and meet the foreign language proficiency requirements as specified in the Appendix. 3. Candidates Subject to English Language Examination "Selection method: Profile assessment and interview by a professional subcommittee, combined with an English language proficiency test" "Applicants eligible for admission, holding a bachelor's degree or a graduation recognition decision for a bachelor's degree (or equivalent or higher) in a relevant major who wish to pursue advanced professional training but have not yet met the foreign language proficiency requirements as stipulated in Clause 1, Article 8 of Decision No. 21/QĐ-DHQQ... Program Objectives	1. General Objectives To train learners to have in-depth expertise in civil law and civil procedure, skills in analyzing and resolving legal situations regarding civil matters and civil procedure, along with professional responsibility and autonomy in study and

	work, enabling them to work in state administrative agencies, enterprises, educational institutions, and research institutes. 2. Specific Objectives 2.1. Knowledge Objectives - To provide learners with a system of in-depth knowledge about civil legal life, enabling them to, on one hand, advise all subjects on legal conduct in civil life; and on the other hand, conduct research to contribute to the refinement of legal doctrine in the civil field. - The specialized areas that the program is designed to focus on are the fundamental contents of property law and contract law, especially common contracts in civil life, issues of property and personal insurance, as well as other specific legal issues in civil practice. With this special emphasis, the master's program in Civil Law and Civil Procedure aims to train high-level experts in the field of justice; develop creative, independent research capabilities; possess the ability to guide scientific research and professional activities; and identify and solve scientific and practical problems. 2.2. Skill Objectives Through essays, in-class discussions, and solving practical case studies, the program helps develop skills in creatively applying theoretical knowledge of current legal life, applying current legal regulations to resolve civil and civil procedure cases in specific situations, especially in advisory work, and forming necessary skills in proficiently researching, analyzing, and processing information. Based on this, learners will be able to identify, strategize, and make appropriate strategic decisions, propose emerging issues in practical legal life, and provide dynamic guidance. 2.3. Autonomy and Responsibility Objectives After the training process, students will have a spirit of self-study and research, be able to identify legal and professional ethical limits by grasping standard thinking in civil and civil procedure activities to behave appropriately; simultaneously, possess the ability to organize work in group research and independent research to enhance lifelong learning capabilities.
