 - o Watch a training video on how to write a LAND Trust plan.

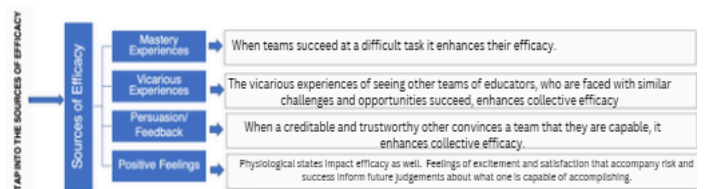
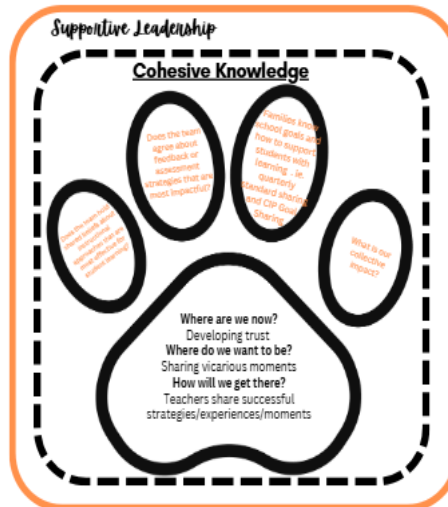

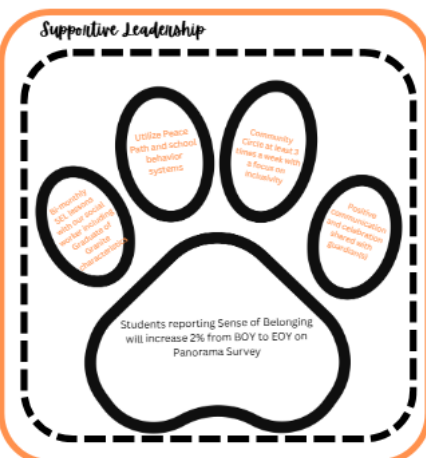
