Dr Steef Peters (M) is the scientific director of Water Insight B.V. He has a PhD in Hydrology (Free University Amsterdam). His expertise is in remote sensing of inland and coastal waters. Dr Steef Peters is specialised in physical modelling, remote sensing of water quality, atmospheric correction, in situ monitoring options, in situ instrument design and software development. Additional interests include climate- and water resource management applications of remote sensing and spatial management of land and water resources.

Dr Peters worked as an assistant professor at the Free University of Amsterdam, where he coordinated the 'CoBIOS' EU-FP7 project and the 'REVAMP' EU-FP5 project. Later at Water Insight he coordinated the FP7 GLaSS and H2020 CoastObs projects. He is a partner in the H2020 Water-ForCE project.

Dr Peters supervised a number of PhD. and MSc. students and is involved in the GEO-AQUAWATCH project
