- Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents during conference periods and other mutually agreed upon times.
- Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows: PTO, class activities, curriculum events, parent-teacher meetings, and virtual meetings and events.

Parent Responsibilities: We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- Monitoring attendance by being present and on time.

- Monitoring the amount of screen time my children use.
- Volunteering, as needed, in my child's classroom.
- Participating, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my children's education.
- Staying informed about my child's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district, and responding as appropriate.
- Serving, to the extent possible, on policy advisory groups such as Campus Improvement Team.

Student Responsibilities: We, as students, will share the responsibility to improve our academics in the following ways:

- Come to school ready to learn.
- Do my homework every day and ask for help when I need it.
- Be respectful of myself and others at all times.
- Be responsible for the amount of screen time I use and complete school work first.
- Give my parents or the adult responsible for my welfare all notices and information every day and return signed papers on time.
