Summary

General Information

"English for Manufacturing" is an intermediate-level course by EnGen that teaches academic and content-specific vocabulary related to manufacturing while also pushing English Language Learners to develop a stronger understanding of main idea and the use of details to support a claim. With 100 lessons (approximately five minutes apiece) on topics including tools and equipment, industry news and trends, personal protective equipment, etc., learners who take the course will find themselves learning from a variety of authentic, relevant texts that increase their knowledge of English while also teaching content related to manufacturing. The activities in this course consistently land around descriptor level 3 (NRS 4) of the English Language Proficiency Standards, as learners answer questions about the key details of texts that demonstrate their understanding of the theme and the development of ideas (ELPS 1 and 6), use semantic and syntactic context to demonstrate understanding of key vocabulary (ELPS 8), and demonstrate their understanding of infinitives, modals, and noun and adverbial clauses to complete sentences (ELPS 10).
