### **GRADUATION PRACTICE - Thursday, June 8th**

Practice: Be on the football field promptly by 9:00 am. We plan to be done by noon. We only have one rehearsal so attendance is mandatory. All participants must be present to hear instructions and for names to be announced correctly. Grad Night t-shirts, which are required for entrance into Grad Night, will be handed out after practice ends at the snack shack. Reminders: Bring water, hat, sunscreen, and sunglasses.

## GRADUATION - Thursday, June 8th, 6:00pm

- <u>Graduation</u> begins at 6:00pm at the Benny Pierce Stadium. Seating is first-come, first-serve. The
  stadium will be open at 5pm. Once the graduates recess, they will go to the Student Center to return their
  loaner gown, gather their personal belongings, pick up their diploma, and will meet their families in the
  parking lot.
- <u>Cap and Gown Pick-up and Drop-off:</u> Cap and gowns can be picked up in the Activities Office. The
   LOANER GOWNS need to be returned to Mrs. Ybarra *IMMEDIATELY* following the ceremony outside the
   Student Center. After returning the gown, the graduate may collect his or her diploma in the same
   location.
- <u>Cap and Gown Reminders:</u> Gowns will need pressing before they are worn. Gowns are designed to be worn with a collared shirt, tie, long pants, and dress shoes or with a dress without high necklines. Suits or sports coats should not be worn under the gown. Casual dress shoes should be worn. Flip flops are NOT acceptable. Avoid wearing very high heels, as the ramp is steep, and heels tend to sink into the turf. Caps: Bobby pins are needed to secure the caps because it is often windy during graduation. Loaner gowns need to be returned to Ms. Ybarra outside the Student Center immediately after the graduation ceremony.
- <u>Graduation Leis:</u> The Junior Class sells "Graduation Leis" as a fundraiser. The last day to purchase a lei is Friday, May 12th at 4:00pm by going to <a href="https://shs.myschoolcentral.com">https://shs.myschoolcentral.com</a>. Graduation leis will be distributed by the Junior Class officers to the student's assigned room prior to graduation.

#### GRAD NIGHT - Thursday, June 8th

- Grad Night Entrance Tickets: The entrance ticket to Grad Night will be the grad night t-shirt. It will be distributed at the end of practice (earlier in the morning at 10:00am) from the snack shack in the Sports Plaza. Grad Night check-in is between 10:00 10:30 pm. No one will be allowed in after 10:30 pm. No one will be allowed to leave until 6:00 am when grad night ends, unless prearranged with your parent(s) prior to grad night. - Memory Boards: Each family will get a poster board from the Grad Night Committee which is 24 x 30 inches. Extra boards are in the SHS office to pick-up. Finished memory boards should be dropped off on Tuesday, June 6th (12-2pm or 4-6pm no later!) in the Large Gym Lobby/Parking Lane. If you absolutely

can not make the June 6th drop off, late boards will be accepted in the LargeGym on Wednesday, June 7th from 9:00-10:00 AM. The boards will be prominently displayed during Grad Night for the students to view. After Grad Night, students can pick up boards from the large gym before they leave. The Grad Night Committee or School Staff will not be responsible for any memory board left after this time.

- Food at Grad Night we will be having dinner starting at 10:00 PM. There will be plenty of other snacks and drinks throughout the evening.
- <u>Grad Night Tips:</u> You will be going through a security check. Bring a jacket or a blanket, wear comfortable closed toe shoes, and wear your Grad Night t-shirt. Do not bring any bags, backpacks, or purses. Do not bring food or beverages. **Under no circumstances will students be permitted to bring empty water bottles or other beverage containers into Grad Night.** You can store your jacket and phone at the coat check.
- <u>Rules:</u> Masks are encouraged at Grad Night. All school policies still apply. There is ZERO TOLERANCE for carrying, distributing, or being under the influence of alcohol or any other substance. The Santa Clara County Sheriffs and/or your parents will be called and you will be removed from Grad Night.
