The festival will be held during the second half of May - June 2022 in Lviv.

The round table will take place during the festival. Due to the pandemic situation, we will send the exact date of the conference to the participants after applying.

Full-time/virtual (online) / distance forms of participation in the round table are allowed.

For full-time participants, we will indicate the location of the round table additionally after applying.

After applying, we will provide participants in the online form with access to the roundtable platform.

The Festival, within its framework, will hold a roundtable on topics

"The phenomenon of fairy tales in the cognitive and educational process of society" and "Modern visualization of a tale: book, scene, animation." Discussing current issues of symbolism, interpretation, and educational content of tales.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS:

The volume of publication – up to 3 pages of standard typed text A4 format (maximum 6,000 signs), in addition to a bibliographic description, which should not exceed the abstract.

Technical parameters: Word Format. Font: Times New Roman, size – 14 pt, spacing – 1.0. Paragraph – 1.25 cm. Margins: left – 30 mm, right – 15 mm, top and bottom – 20 mm.

Order of the material placement. The first line of the case indicates the surname, name, patronymic of the author; below: brief reference of the author (international scientific identifications (ORCID, Scopus Author ID, etc.), the field of activity, institution; position, scientific degree, and academic title - if there are at least one of the positions); the next line is country and city. Title of the report (message, speech) - in capital letters, bold, centered formatting. Next is the main text, which indicates the relevance, status of the study, novelty, main results, conclusions, and sources used. Text alignment - width.

Bibliographic description of literary (information) sources consists of the standard APA (American Psychological Association). References to the literary sources are indicated by continuous numbering in square brackets (e.g. [34, p.86]) or [52, p.86-91]. The list of sources and literature is submitted at the end in the reference line.

A maximum number of ***illustrations*** if necessary - three, format *.tif or *.jpg, volume - up to 10 MB each, resolution 300 dpi.

Materials of the thesis must necessarily be based on the research results and do not contain logic, stylistic, typographic errors. The authors are responsible for the contents of the correctness of the thesis reference. To be accepted, The materials are accepted only if not previously published.

The registration fee for participants of all forms of participation is 5 euros.

Abstracts are published in the author's edition. The Editorial Board reserves the right to select abstracts for publication. Materials that do not meet these requirements will not be considered.

Theses selected by the organizing committee will be published in the almanac of the Festival after its holding.
