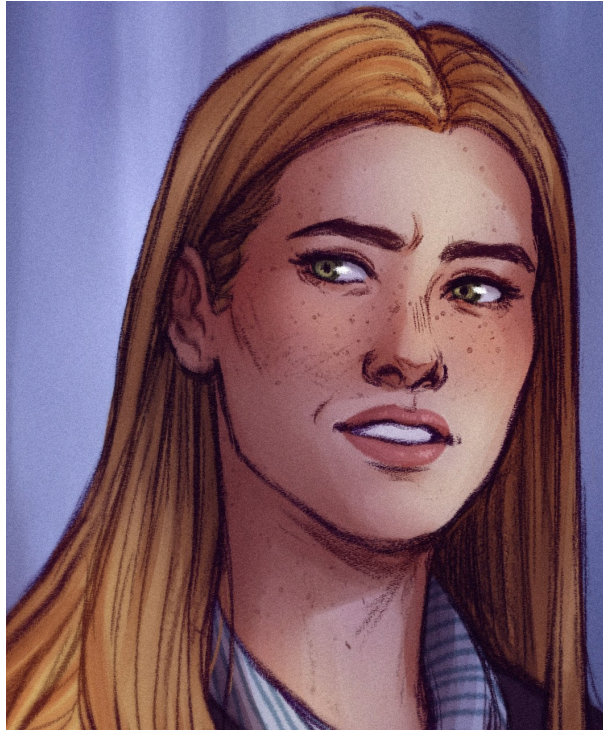


Abigail Maverick
