

Installing Home Assistant Community Store (HACS)

Allowing Additional Functionality

STEP 0: Create Github account

If you already have a Github account, continue to Step 1.

Otherwise, go to <https://github.com> and follow the instructions to create an account.

STEP 1: Install SSH add-on

Go to Settings→Add-ons→Add-on Store and search for “Terminal & SSH”, if it is not showing up, please make sure “Advanced mode” is enabled, to enable Advanced mode, go to your profile (Bottom left corner) scroll down the the end of “User Settings” and enable “Advanced mode”. Once enabled go back and search for “Terminal & SSH”. Once there click install

Once installed, enable Show in sidebar, and either click on the sidebar icon, or click on “open web ui”



Terminal

That will take you to the Home Assistant Terminal where you can download HACS.

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STEP 2: Download and Install HACS

Once on the terminal run this command:

`"wget -O - https://get.hacs.xyz | bash -" (without the "")`

Alternatively you can try following these instructions

Once the command has finished, go to settings, click the 3 dots on the top right and restart Home Assistant.



Once HA has restarted, go to Settings, Devices & Services, Add Integration and search for HACS

Mark all boxes except the last one and submit.

Before you can setup HACS you need to acknowledge the following



I know how to access Home Assistant logs



I know that there are no add-ons in HACS



I know that everything inside HACS including HACS itself is custom and untested by Home Assistant



I know that if I get issues with Home Assistant I should disable all my custom_components



Enable experimental features, this is what eventually will become HACS 2.0.0, if you enable it now you do not need to do anything when 2.0.0 is released
