4. Accommodations

- a. Each qualifying school is responsible for arranging and paying for all accommodations to SHSAA Regional competitions.
- b. Accommodation information for each regional can be found on the SHSAA website (see above link)
- c. Please communicate all accommodation information to your athletes and parent group

5. Transportation

- a. Each qualifying school is responsible for arranging and paying for all travel to SHSAA Regional competitions.
- b. School division administrative policies must be adhered to when using parent volunteers. Please confirm with your school's principal.
- c. Student departure will be determined by the coach.

6. Meals

- a. Athletes and coaches are responsible for all meals.

7. Dress

- a. Please bring warm clothing.
- b. Dress for all possible weather conditions.
- c. Team Uniforms
 - i. SHSAA Policy for team uniforms must be adhered to.

8. Athlete Conduct

- a. Remind all athletes that they are ambassadors of your school and the Saskatoon Secondary School Athletic Directorate (SSSAD).
- b. Expectations for all athletes are that you are polite and respectful to all organizers, volunteers, officials, and competitors at the provincial competition.
- c. Please communicate to your athletes and parents that drug, alcohol, and tobacco use are strictly prohibited on any SSSAD sanctioned trip. Any athlete involved in such activity will be returned home at their own expense.
- d. Curfew times will be established and enforced by the school coaching staffs.
