- 1) Budget:
 - a. On track to stay within planned budget for fiscal year
 - b. Fiscal year 2023 tax returns have been submitted
 - c. Checking (operating) account bank balance is \$97838
 - d. Existing budget will consume \$45k of this
- 2) Uniform replacement process will take 6-12 months and will need to be replaced in 4 to 5 years and uniform replacement is expected to cost approx. \$100k
- 3) 100k is our income every year - we can rollover 10% of this to the checking account, rest can be put aside in savings account for uniforms
- 4) Need to finalize next academic year's budget so that we can let the school know how much we will ask for donations
