4. File format: MS Word (.docx)

6. Contributors must agree that if the submission is accepted for presentation in this conference, their abstracts will be included and published in electronic or paper publications such as conference proceedings, conference website, conference manual, etc., to facilitate academic information exchange.

Guidelines for Brief Research Paper for Review:

1. A brief research paper should include the research purpose, significance, methodology, results, discussions, key tables and figures, and references.
2. Brief research papers should not exceed 3 pages.
3. All text should be set to 12-point Times New Roman, left-aligned, single-spaced.
4. A4 paper size, with standard margin.
5. File format: MS Word (.docx)
6. The submitted file includes a one page abstract, and a brief research paper within 3 pages for review.
7. Please format the text and references following the 7th edition APA format.
8. Brief research papers are only for review, conference organizer will not use this document for any other purpose.
