DEADLINES: Visitation Verification forms are due to the Programming VP each trimester (Aug. 1st; Dec. 1st and April 1st)

GENERAL RULES:

1. The Roadrunner contest goes from April 1st – March 21st of next year.
2. The Visitation Verification Form must be sent to the Programming VP for each visitation within the time frame they took place and must be set to deadlines .
3. Roadrunner Visitation Verification Forms **MUST** be signed by an officer of the chapter visited or a State Board member, other than one from your chapter.
4. The person signing the form must have attended the event.
5. A Visitation is official when:
 - a) One member from your chapter attends the event
 - b) Members of the Nebraska Women of Today Executive Committee will not count
6. One member or more will count for a State Convention. Members of the Nebraska Women of Today Executive Committee will qualify.
7. Roadrunner Forms are for miles traveled within the State of Nebraska and will be the only ones accepted.
8. Any of the following could be counted as a visitation:

Membership Meetings	State Meetings	Socials to other towns
Inter-Clubs	Extension Follow-Ups	Most any organized function
9. If the Visitation does not count, you will receive a form back with an explanation from Programming VP
10. Certificates will be given to chapters who make visits to other chapter functions, social or Inter-Club.
