

Arizona State University –Facts & Figures 2024

Arizona State University (ASU) is the largest public university in the United States. ASU has four campuses within the Phoenix metropolitan area (Tempe, West, Polytechnic, and Downtown). In 2024, ASU welcomed 17,000 incoming first-year students and accepted 90% of student application, demonstrating our commitment to educational access. Of those first-year students 52% identify as a minority, reflecting our commitment of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. Furthermore, ASU had a first-year retention rate of 85%, exceeding the national average and becoming the highest in the state.

ASU is a top ranked, comprehensive public research university guided, according to its charter, “not by whom we exclude, but rather whom we include and how they succeed; advancing research and discovery of public value; and assuming fundamental responsibility for the economic, social, cultural and overall health of the communities it serves.” ASU supports research with extensive infrastructure and institutional support, providing a scientific environment that contributes to the success of all research faculty and projects. ASU has the largest undergraduate enrollment in the nation, educating nearly 80,000 undergraduate and graduate students in person and another 72,000 students online. ASU is proud to be designated a Hispanic-Serving Institution by the U.S. Department of Education. ASU strives to reflect the community around it, while responding to its needs. As a function of its size, location and current diversity, ASU is optimally positioned to create and evaluate new models of inclusion, and, in doing so, advance the teaching, research, and human resource imperatives that will guide higher education in the decades to come.
