Task Descriptions
<u>Guidelines:</u> - Work on the topic assigned to you. - Identify the roots and all related words derived from your topic. - Create your own storyboard about the topic, clearly stating the moral. - Your story may be original or taken from the Qur'an or Hadith. - Include at least 1 verse from the Qur'an or 1 Hadith to support your story.* - Be prepared to present your storyboard in class. <u>Focus on:</u> Storyboard: ● Create a storyboard of 1–2 pages with 4–8 pictures (hand-drawn or digital). ● Write 1–2 sentences under each picture to describe what is happening. ● Clearly state the moral of your story* ● Ensure your writing is neat and easy to read. ● Check your grammar and sentence structure. ● Submit your completed storyboard. Presentation: ● Begin by introducing yourself. ● Show your storyboard to the class. ● Introduce the topic of your story. ● Describe what is happening in each picture. ● Explain the moral of the story (or let the class figure it out). ● Invite the students to ask any questions they may have. ● Ask the students 3 or more questions about the story. ● End by thanking the students for listening.

Be ready to present your work using posters or computers (ex. power point).
Hand in / Upload into Google classroom your (1) storyboard and (2) presentation.

“Indeed, Allah commands you to deliver the trusts to their rightful owners.” (Qur’an 4:58)

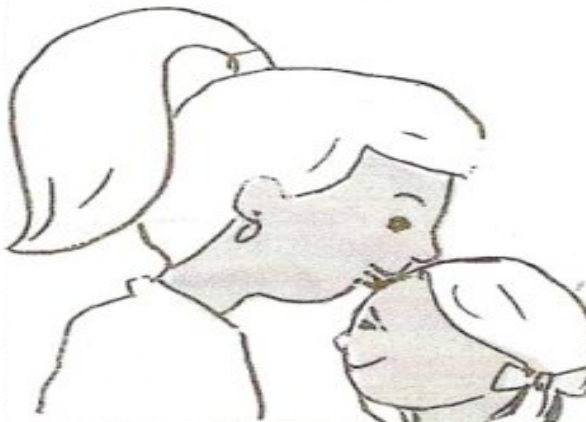
Amina is a beloved girl because of her good morals. The following story tells us about her faithfulness.
