

1. Children who receive free or reduced-price meals at school : will soon receive money to buy food through the Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) program.

- The P-EBT benefits will be added to the Ohio Direction cards of families that receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits.
- Families that do not receive SNAP benefits will be sent P-EBT cards with the one-time benefit added. No application is needed.

- For questions about your child's eligibility for free and reduced meals on or before April 29, please contact 740-852-5700.

ODJFS has provided additional assistance to SNAP recipients during the pandemic:

- Those who did not already receive the maximum monthly allotment for their household size in March and April were issued additional payments. This same benefit will be issued in May, as well.
- Administrative verifications normally required at food banks were waived, to streamline the process and limit person-to-person contact.
- Recertification periods for March, April, and May were extended by six months. June recertifications also will be extended.
- Recipients can take advantage of "click and collect" payment options to order groceries online and pay at pickup.

****Individuals may qualify for SNAP if their household's gross monthly income is at or under 130% of the federal poverty guidelines. Ohioans can apply at benefits.ohio.gov.***

2. Food Thru Faith 51 W. Center St. London, OH 43140 (740-852-4735)

Requirements: Must have a London address/zip code, proof of residency and social security card for every family member receiving food.

3. HELP House Community Outreach 122 E. Center St. London, OH 43140 (740-852-1980)

Open: Mondays 4p to 7pm, Wednesdays 9a -12pm, & Saturdays 9a - 11am. Families can receive food once a week from the food pantry. *Drive thru/Walk up only

Loving Kindness Kitchen (Soup Kitchen) at the same location is open weekly on Mondays from 5p - 6:30 pm.

Requirements: None

4. Madison County Food Pantry 137 Maple St. London, OH 43140 (740-852-5822 ext.1)

Open: Wednesdays & Saturdays 9a – 11:45am. Families can receive food once a month. *Drive thru only

Requirements: None at this time.

5. London Church of the Nazarene 224 Elm St. London (740) 852-3498:

Blessing Box located in the church's front yard is stocked with non-perishable food and toiletries, accessible 24/7.

6. The Welcome Table St. Paul AME Church 11 Center St. London, OH 43140

Open: Thursday 5pm-7pm, serving a nutritious meal carry out style.
