	A Goal page: Flipped through this online book to read a paragraph summary of each of the 17 UN Sustainable goals.
	A Goal page: My teacher assigned me one to investigate further with a partner.
	A Goal page: Outlined my video: Used the drop-down arrow next to Goals on the menu on this UN page About Sustainable Development to find out more about the issue I am exploring.
