Description: This league is for golfers with experience. Golfers should have a minimum handicap index of 20 for 9 holes or 40 if you keep an 18-hole handicap. Golfers will be assigned a foursome each week, rotating players. You will play with different people each week **based on handicap**. The LPGA Amateur Golf Association strongly encourages each Chapter to provide networking opportunities to its members.

Please remember to enter your scores weekly on whatever system you currently use to maintain your handicap after EVERY game you play. Every player must have a verifiable handicap to be part of this league.

Information to Remember:

- **Weekly Evite:** Every Thursday you will receive an **Evite** regarding details of league play for the following week. **PLEASE RSVP ONLY YES** by Monday at 9:00am. Do not respond "MAYBE." This will be considered a "NO." Let me know if you are playing 18 or 9 holes.
- **Special Requests/Guests:** If there are open slots, you are allowed to bring a guest. You would be limited to two times only for that person during the season. Guest names should be provided in the comment section of your Evite RSVP and the number of Guests should be marked as "2". Guest names must be received far enough in advance to be assigned to a foursome.
- **Arrival:** You should be at your cart 15 minutes PRIOR to your tee time each week.

- **Cancellation Process:** Please contact Nancy Dofflemyer by Monday 12:00pm if you must cancel. You will receive your tee-times Monday 4:00pm the day before play.

It is time consuming to put the foursomes together and we would appreciate your cooperation on this. Please be aware of our Chapter's Cancellation Policy *if you fail to cancel by the day/time identified by your League Captain in the Welcome Letter, you will not be invited to play the following week. After three incidents, your name will be removed from that league's roster for the remainder of the season.*

- **Prizes:** The Sunset League competition/end of the season prize will be awarded to Most Improved player based on reduced handicap index during our season. Eligibility for the prize is 50% attendance during the **official season** which runs from May 26th until September 8th.
- **After Golf Time:** For those interested, we can enjoy a cocktail and/or light fare immediately following our play in Lighthouse Sound restaurant.
- **Rain:** In case of light rain, we will golf. If there is lightning and/or heavy downpour, golf will be cancelled. If in doubt, call the golf course 410-641-0416. A decision to cancel due to weather will be made by 12 noon on the day of play.
- **Please remember** to take care of/tip your bag drop staff and cart staff. They work hard to make our golf experience a pleasant one.

Golf Etiquette and Rules for Pace of Play:

1. Park the cart toward the back of the green.
2. Play ready golf.
3. Record your score at the next hole.
4. Don't talk when you or someone else is hitting.
5. Carry the clubs you'll most likely use when approaching your ball.
6. Pick up your ball after you have reached your net double bogey, so we can keep the pace of play moving.
7. Hit as soon as the group in front of you is out of range.
8. Drop your cart partner off at her ball or park between each played ball.
9. Hit a provisional ball whenever you think your ball may have gone out of bounds.
