Our Mission

CTE Internship gives students the opportunity to learn a variety of skills by expanding the walls of classroom learning to include the community. By narrowing the gap between theory and practice, CTE internship creates important work-based learning experiences for students.



CTE Internship provides opportunities for students to learn a variety of skills through rigorous academic preparation with hands-on career development experiences. Under the guidance of adult mentors, students learn to work in teams, solve problems, shadow in a business of their choice, and meet employers' expectations.

Student Career Internships

You Sometimes you can even get paid for it! This internship should be a "capstone" experience after students have taken a minimum of one related course in their area of interest. Also helps students in completing a Career Pathway! Internships fall under a CTE area which include: Family & Consumer Sciences, Woodworking & Drafting, Agriculture, Digital Media, Business, Marketing & IT, Technology & Engineering and Health Science/ Medical. Internships are only available on "B" days.

Internship Requirements:

- Students will fill out the online application form and include all attachments.
- Students should discuss their internship and their interests with Mrs. Beck.
- Students should not have a problem with attendance or tardiness.
- Students need one related CTE class to take internship (it can have been taken in the previous year)
- If a medical internship is desired, it is required that Anatomy and Physiology be taken prior to completing an internship OR have your CNA certification.
- After Mrs. Beck approves the internship she will register the students for "CTE Internship" which is the course title. There is some flexibility in hours based on the specific internship.

Students may suggest an internship/ mentor for their internship. Mrs. Beck will make contact with the mentor to explain the program and the employer's expectations. Mrs. Beck will set up all MEDICAL or HEALTH-related internships. These spots are limited. Students interested in a medical internship must get a series of immunizations and attend a hospital orientation. Please do NOT contact a hospital or medical clinic to set up your own internship! All medical internships go through the Work-based Learning Coordinator.
