RIPPLE EFFECTS OF WORLD WAR I

Purpose

World War I created a ripple effect that reached far beyond the battlefield. In this activity, you'll organize what you've learned to reveal the true reach of total war.

Process

- 1. Look at each "ripple" (ring) on the diagram on the next page. Each ring represents a group of people affected by World War I, with those closest to the fighting in the center and those farther from combat in the outer rings. The sources and stories you explored in this lesson touched on all these groups.
- 2. Choose any **three** rings. For each one, write **a new and specific detail** about how the war impacted that group of people. Either write your responses inside the rings or draw a line from the ring you're writing about.
- 3. Be ready to share what you wrote—and which source helped you understand each new detail!
