Grimes will follow up and share information

As of yesterday, Holcomb stated that where a classroom or place of instruction can be configured so that all students can maintain at least 3 feet of social distancing from one another at all times, and where students are positioned to face in the same direction, face coverings or shields do not need to be worn during in person educational instruction by students. Will this change at SHCSC for our students?

Admin will address-

I am concerned about students eating breakfast in our rooms. Can we not have only students eating breakfast in the cafeteria (not hanging out with their friends - not everyone eats in the cafeteria, they are just hanging out)? I am concerned about students being maskless in my room, especially if they are in our rooms for an extended time before school begins.

Admin will address-

What will the guidelines be for hall passes and allowing students to leave your classroom to go to the restroom, go to their locker, go to the library, or run an errand for a teacher? Will students be allowed in the hallway during class time?

Admin will address-

Students that are TA's --- are they going to be allowed to use the copiers?

What if a student has someone at home that tests positive? That student would isolate but what about the students in class with them? Should they isolate themselves as well? Teachers too? **Contact of a contact does not count and warrant quarantine.**

Will we be provided hand sanitizer for our classrooms?

Is the requirement for 2 negative tests prior to returning not applicable anymore?

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When are we (staff and students) going to be allowed to take masks off?

If you can't properly distance your studs due to numbers, are they then required to wear their mask the entire time they are in your classroom?

Admin will address -

If we are considered to be fragile health (immune compromised, health conditions, age, etc.), are we allowed to require masks at all times in our classroom?

If we have allergies, asthma, chronic headaches do we need a doctors note stating this fact?

Response: Need a medical statement from doctor ruling out covid

If my kid or me has allergies, (runny nose, headache, sore throat, and/or cough), are we supposed to stay home and do we need a doctor's note everyday to return? I see this getting very inconvenient (when their student is sent home daily) and expensive for parents.

Response: Need a medical statement from doctor of underlying conditions/ruling out covid

Do Staff have additional sick time for this year?

10 days covid pay not pulled from your sick days

If you test NEGATIVE for Covid, you still can not return for 10 days??

Admin will address -

Will cafeteria staff need to take daily attendance?

If a student in my room tests positive and they have had masks off during to "3 or 6 ft" distancing who quarantines? Eastridge has assured families there will be time in the day to take off masks. Can I require them to wear it?

So if a student or teacher had COVID and now has no fever but has other symptoms are they cleared to return?

If a student is in a classroom setting where they are outside of the 6' social distance, is it appropriate for them to remove mask? Do any other situations exist where students may remove a mask to provide a break from being covered?

So a kid goes home with a fever and sore throat, or more symptoms. Parent takes them to be tested, we know it takes days to get back results so should siblings be allowed in school while waiting for results? If so, How does that keep us safe?

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If a teacher's kid gets sent home with a headache or sore throat, does the teacher have to leave school and quarantine as well?
