#### **REVERSE EVACUATION**

#### A. WHEN

- You observe a potential threat or hazard outside and activate the response action.
- You are notified via CodeRED
- You are notified by the organization's intercom and/or mass notification system
- You are directed to take this action by supervisors or emergency personnel.

## **B.WHY**

Activated when it is necessary for staff, students, and patrons to enter the facility quickly in order to avoid a dangerous or potentially dangerous situation outside the building.

### C. RESPONSIBILITIES

- Before:
  - Staff: Will undergo incident management training and participate in response action training and drills. Staff assigned to work with students/staff with access and functional needs will undergo in-depth training. Will familiarize themselves with the mass notification systems in use. Register for CodeRED and the organization's mass notification system.
  - Students: Will participate in response action training and drills.
  - Emergency Management and Public Safety Personnel: Will review and provide input into the plan. Will assist in providing training for staff and participate in exercises.
- During:
  - Staff: Announce Reverse Evacuation response action to the staff/students in their area. Take part in the Reverse Evacuation response action when directed.
  - Students: Take part in the Reverse Evacuation response action when directed.

# D. HOW

- a) Outdoor Procedure:
  - Announce, "Reverse Evacuation!" loudly and warn individuals outside using a whistle or horn if available
  - Walk guickly into the nearest entrance.
    - People with disabilities or access and functional needs will be assisted by specific staff who have been trained.
    - Moving infants may involve additional staff to ensure they are safely returned to their designated rooms.
  - Notify the Incident Commander/Office/Principal (if the action was not initiated by them).
  - Report to your designated location until Incident Commander announced "all clear".

- Check for injuries.
- Teacher/Floor Warden will take attendance.
- Await further instructions and prepare for other response actions if needed
