

DB Feud 2024 - Game 3 (#30)

(requires 2 teams of 3-5 players each)

Rules

You are to separate into 2 teams of equal size.

In each round, a member of each team is gathered and the two are presented with a question and the number of top answers.

Each question was answered by 100, 200 or 300 chat members.

NORMALLY each group would have something common between them which may or may not help you answer, but this time... Nah.

All encompassing and none encompassing answers are not counted nor included. For example, if the question is "What is your favorite ice cream flavor?" "All of them" or "I don't like ice cream" would not be included as potential answers.

As always, other popular answers that do not fit the category or the spirit of the question are included.

A player must buzz-in and give an answer. If the answer is not on the board or not the top answer, the contestant who didn't buzz in can give an answer.

The player with the topmost answer may choose to play or pass the question to the other team.

The team members must then each give an answer that fits the category. If it's on the board, the points for the answer are added to the bank. If it's not, the team gets a strike.

After three strikes, the opposing team gets the chance to give a single answer that has yet to be revealed on the board. If they get it right, they win the bank. If not, the playing team is awarded the banked points.

After 4 rounds, the team with the most points gets to play the bonus round.

   Game note   

Game note: As mentioned, this is the 10th year of these stupid games and the 30th iteration of the Desert Bus Feud.

I figured this nice round number is the perfect occasion to celebrate the joy of randomness.

Now, could I have used random.org? A tool I use all the time? Yes. yes I could have.

The following 16 questions (out of 25 remaining questions) and their order were selected from the seven hundred forty-five quadrillion possible combinations using the seed

“FARTBUSFARTBVSFARTBESFARTMUSFARTBUTTBUTTFARTFRESHBUSFO
CKOFROSHBUSWETBUSBLADEBUSPIPEBUSDICETUBETUUUBUSFROOGB

Round 1 (We asked 100 chat members who submitted their survey at a time ending with a 2)

You're stranded in the desert, the Sun is scorching. There's nothing in sight. What do you want the most?

1. Shade - 27
2. Water - 20
3. To not be there - 18
4. A teleporter - 5
5. AC - 4

Round 2 (All chat members were asked to roll a d20. We asked the 100 who rolled 8 (points), 16 (crashes) or 14 (bug splats))

Go to your bathroom. What pattern do you see on your toilet paper?

1. Flowers - 28
2. Diamonds - 17
3. Waves - 9
4. Dots - 8
5. Quilted - 5
6. Bears - 3

Round 3 – (We asked the 200 chat members **who used the most Es across all their answers)**

If Dorothy (from the Wizard of Oz) was arrested near the end of the movie, what crime would she be accused of?

1. Murder / Manslaughter / Witchslaughter - 108
2. Trespassing - 16
3. Assault with a deadly weapon (a house) - 15
4. Theft - 9
5. Disturbing the Peace - 8
6. Use of an Illicit substance - 6
7. Tax Evasion - 5
8. Fleeing the scene of a crime / Failure to report - 4

   Special Round 3.5   

Round 3.5 (there are no graphics for this round) –

Every participant was asked to flip a coin 10 times.

Every morning you've had giveaways for an amount that ended in either an even or odd digit.

The single participant who matched the first two giveaways every day with their coin flips (tails, tails, heads, heads, tails, tails, heads, tails, heads, tails) is male, from Pennsylvania born in 1988.

He's right handed, wakes up at 6:30 AM, wears glasses and likes to drink water.

In this round you have to guess HIS answers.

For each question, both teams may give an answer. Each correct answer awards the team 10 points.

- 1. Name a profession you have to be excessively strong to do well**

Mover

- 2. Besides actual food, name something you might eat or ingest if you weren't paying attention**

A bug

- 3. Name something wrong with a hotel room that would put you off from staying there**

Dirty room

- 4. Name something a student may give a teacher**

Apple

- 5. If you ran a store located between Tucson and Vegas, what would you sell would-be bus drivers?**

Caffeine pills

- 6. Name something you can cook if you don't know how to cook**

Mac and Cheese

Round 4 – (We asked the 300 chat members who submitted their survey in number order that matches a historical completed GivAGami)

What does a good theme park HAS to have?

1. Bathrooms - 59
2. Rollercoaster - 57
3. Food / snacks - 57
4. Themed Rides - 54
5. Gate / entrance - 10
6. staff - 10
7. Gift shop - 5
8. Midway/arcade - 4

Bonus Round – Rules

2 members of the winning team must collectively gather 200 points by answering 6 questions. (the responses were chosen using the chat log from each day of the run as a seed) 1 player leaves the room.

The remaining player gets 30 seconds to give 1 answer to each of the following questions. Points are then counted.

The player who left returns to the room and gets 45 seconds to give different answers to the same questions. Same/similar answers are buzzed out and a different answer may be given.

If the team has collectively got 200 points, they win. If not, they lose.

There are no prizes.
