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| <p><b>With WHOM will you share your E-Portfolio?</b></p>   | <p>My E-Portfolio will be shared with parents, teachers, administrators, possibly students, and any other person who has access to my classroom website, as it is open to the public.</p>  |
| <p><b>WHAT will you share from your E-Portfolio? Consider the role of each stakeholder.</b></p>  | <p>Every part of my E-Portfolio will be shared with stakeholders. Each section in the E-Portfolio could potentially benefit a parent of a child with disabilities, or any parent at all, by helping their child better access curriculum. The sections on Reading, Writing, Low Incidence Tools, and the IEP process could help a parent to know what is available for his/her daughter, and what his/her child's rights are. Many times ignorance prevents children from getting access to the tools they need. Teachers could benefit especially from the section on the SAMR model and Bloom's Digital Taxonomy, as many of my colleagues probably went through teacher credentialing programs before the revision of Bloom's Taxonomy. These learning theories are key to ensuring that our students are accessing higher order thinking skills, and that we are using technology in a meaningful way.</p> |
