<p>What did people call the first Spanish constitution?</p> <p>La Pepa</p>	<p>Why did people call La Pepa the first Spanish constitution?</p> <p>Because it was approved on Saint José's day</p>	<p>What were the fundamentals of La Pepa?</p> <p>National sovereignty resides in the people; equality and freedom; catholic religion as the official religion; Fernando VII as king of Spain; population in the Spanish colonies were considered Spanish citizens</p>
<p>What did Fernando VII do when he became king?</p> <p>He established an absolute monarchy, abolished the constitution, repressed liberals, and abolished the salic law.</p>	<p>Did Fernando VII have a parliamentary monarchy?</p> <p>No, he didn't. He established an absolute monarchy.</p>	<p>Did Isabel II have a parliamentary monarchy?</p> <p>Yes, she did.</p>

<p>How did Isabel II's reign finish?</p> <p>She went into exile. And Amadeo de Saboya became King of Spain.</p>	<p>Why do we call the Spanish Restoration when Alfonso XII became King of Spain?</p> <p>Because the Bourbon family came back to the Spanish throne</p>	<p>What were the consequences of the Industrial Revolution?</p> <p>People emigrated from the countryside to the cities; craftsmen became factory workers; cities became bigger.</p>
