


Please review this document (3 pages) that provides important information about the following events for Cherokee Elementary School:

## DIRECTIONS

- Enter the parking lot of Cherokee Village First Baptist Church (Iroquois Drive).
- Take the lane to the back corner of the church parking lot and enter the elementary school from the gravel drive.
- Loop back towards Iroquois Drive at the end of the 1st grade wing and drop your student(s) off at the cones set up along the marked lane.
- Exit the parking lot back to Iroquois Drive **OR** take Rebel Drive towards the A.L. Hutson Center.

# Afternoon: Parent Pick-Up



## DIRECTIONS

- Enter the parking lot of Cherokee Village First Baptist Church.
- Loop the parking lot and continue the line down the drive into the elementary school parking lot.
- The **FRONT** of the line will form at the far edge of the island and will be marked by a .
- When the car rider line begins moving for dismissal, it will travel across the front of the building in the bus lane.
- Car riders will be picked up in front of the elementary gym (pick-up spots will be labeled with ).
- Exit the car rider line by taking the bus lane to enter Rebel Drive.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION for the start of school

Renovations continue on campus, making the front entrance inaccessible at this time. We understand that it may be necessary for a parent/guardian to enter the building for one of the following reasons:

- Dropping off medication
- Registering a new student
- Attending a scheduled parent meeting
- Picking up a student early
