Families enjoy the art opening reception and appreciate the beautifully framed artwork that is returned to them after the show (the following November). This is a great way to showcase what we do.

\*The MEA will accept **30 eligible works** of student art on a first-come sign-up basis.

\* Size limit: length + width **cannot exceed 30 inches**.
