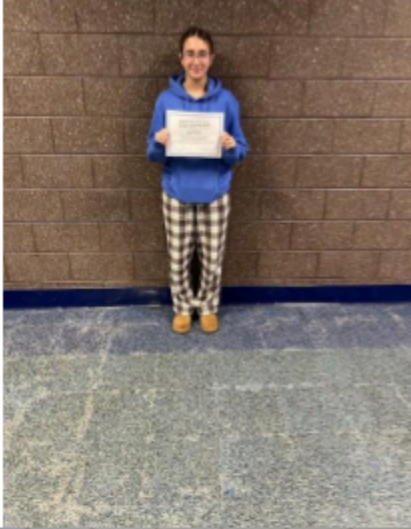

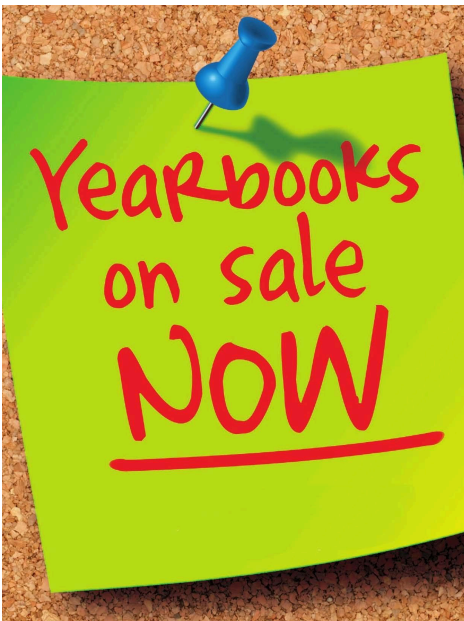


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Board of Education Meeting Updates

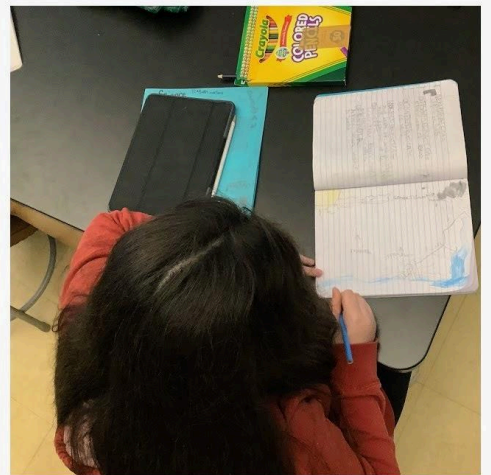
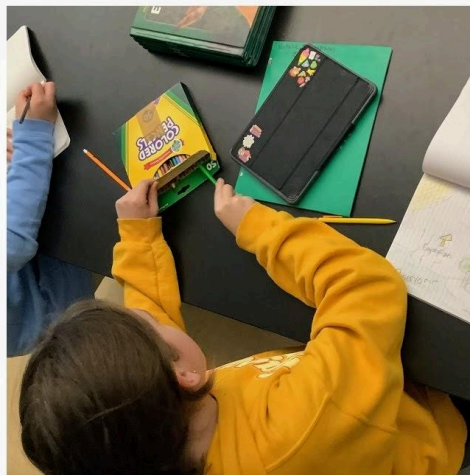
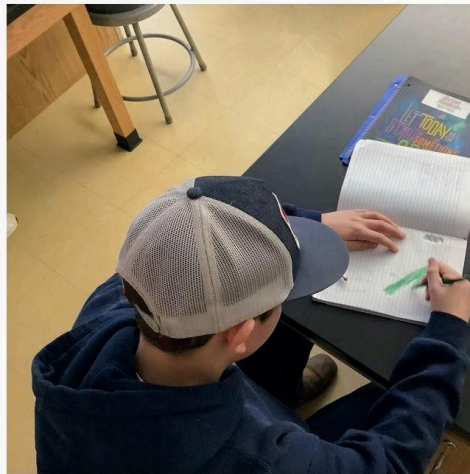
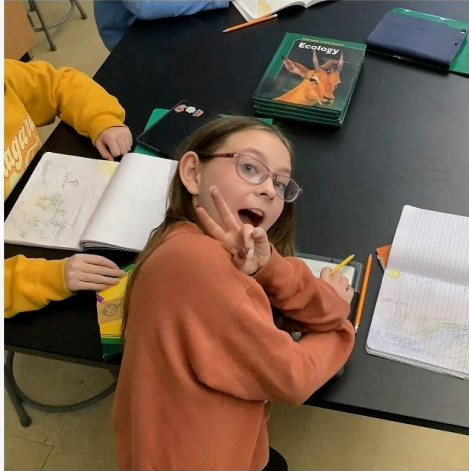


Ms. Seekamp's 6th Grade WIN class earned some free time after working hard on Spring Math. We love to play Spoons!
