PROS:

CONS:

CONS:

The particles can sometimes be a bit harsh on your cat's feet. They don't seem to mind too much, but it looks a bit uncomfortable to stand on just by looking at it.

The dust factor can be an issue if you do not ventilate the area after filling the litter box. My cat was sensitive to dust particles and sometimes sneezed when using the litter box.

Its most significant issue, as it can be with clay-based litter, is the spread. It attaches to your cat's paws and is easily sprayed outside the box because of its lightweight form as soon as your cat starts burying its business.

The clumps created tend to be very big. While the clumps are firm, this uses much more material than needed.
