Why is pre-tribulation Rapture false? Where does it come from?

Pre-tribulation rapture and dispensationalism are false teachings introduced by Francisco Ribera and Manuel Lacuzna; two Jesuits who were tasked with distracting Protestants from the idea that the Roman Pope is 'Antichrist', which was an early belief held by Luther and other reformists. Rapturism was adopted and promoted by people like John Darby and later integrated into Protestantism through the ecumenical movement.

Please read their works, including "Apocalyptic Commentary", to further understand the Jesuit "futurism" concept. Some Christians believe that this theology — rapture and dispensationalism — were introduced to sabotage and delegitimize the Protestant Churches. For example:

Interpreting Biblical Symbolism:

As we will see in these examples, there is scriptural precedent for the Lord removing his children before enforcing judgment upon a land. We are not meant to "survive through" the tribulation — that's like a child acting "brave" or cocky with a parent while being punished! We are supposed to be afraid of punishment, supposed to want to escape. There is no "fighting through" the tribulation — God has already won the fight, he doesn't need us for anything (Job 35:5-9, Ezekiel 39:23). This is why he is revealing his plans to us.

Noah escapes in the Ark

Genesis 7:7 - And Noah and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives entered the ark to escape the waters of the flood. [Remember Israel turns 77 in 2025]

Genesis 7:13 - On that very day Noah and his sons, Shem, Ham and Japheth, together with his wife and the wives of his three sons, entered the ark

Genesis 7:20 - The waters rose and covered the mountains to a depth of more than **fifteen cubits** [= 23 feet]

Lot's escape from Sodom to Zoar

Genesis 19:11, Matthew 24:24, 2 Thess 2:11 \rightarrow (9-1):(1+1), (4+2):(4-2), (2+2):(1+1) \rightarrow 8:2, 6:2, 4:2 Genesis 19:12-13 - [= Sept 23] The two men said to Lot, "Do you have anyone else here—sons-in-law, sons or daughters, or anyone else in the city who belongs to you? Get them out of here, because we are going to destroy this place. The outcry to the Lord against its people is so great that he has sent us to destroy it." Genesis 19:16 - [rapture symbolism] And while he lingered, the men took hold of his hand, his wife's hand, and the hands of his two daughters, the Lord being merciful to him, and they brought him out and set him outside the city.

Jacob divides his camp; sends wives over ford Jabbok

Genesis 32:7-8 - In great fear and distress Jacob divided the people who were with him into two groups, and the flocks and herds and camels as well. He thought, "If Esau comes and attacks one group, the group that is left may escape."

Genesis 32:10 vs Joshua 4:23 - Jacob crosses Jordan and divides 2 camps; Israelites crossed Jordan Genesis 32:23 - After he had sent them across the stream, he sent over all his possessions Genesis 32:32 - Therefore to this day the Israelites do not eat the tendon attached to the socket of the hip, because the socket of Jacob's hip was touched near the tendon. [please also read in KJV]
Revelation 19:16 - On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Ameeeen!!! Please read Genesis 32; Jacob represents Jesus. The "gifts" that he sends ahead of himself are represented by Luke 21:36 – the first fruits found "worthy to escape" via rapture. Afterwards, Jacob is left alone to fight; similarly, after Revelation 19:16, Jesus face human and demonic armies (which we know are technically allowed by God as means of judgment, Ezekiel 38, Jeremiah 15:3, Jeremiah 16:10-13; Jesus is therefore a grace from God, to act as our Advocate, Defender and Mediator)

Moses sent Zipporah back to Father (Jethro)

Exodus 18:2-3 - After Moses had sent away his wife Zipporah, his father-in-law Jethro received her and her two sons. One son was named Gershom, for Moses said, "I have become a foreigner in a foreign land";

Please read Exodus 18; Moses represents Jesus, of course, but it's likely Jethro metaphorically represents the Father (ie: they commune together; meet in tabernacle; Moses receives instruction from Jehtro; etc). So, Moses sent Zipporah to Jethro before returning to Egypt with Aaron to face Pharaoh and the plagues.

Jacob keeps Benjamin in Canaan (promised land) but sends sons Genesis 42

David fights Goliath - 1 samuel 17, 2 samuel 20 Man against Benjamin - Judges 9-10 Samson fights Philistine armies - Judges 5-6
