Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 school year educational progress for Dollar Bay-Tamarack City Area Schools. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. Our school has not been given one of these labels.

DB-TC Area School staff have been implementing a Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) to improve student achievement and maintain a positive school climate. We teach behavior expectations across all areas, have successfully rolled out Tier I and II behavior and reading systems, and use data to drive decision-making. We hold school assemblies and "stores" to celebrate and reward meeting goals and expectations.

1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

New students enrolling at Dollar Bay-Tamarack City Area Schools register with the office immediately, with guardians providing birth certificate, immunization record, and proof of residency. High School students are enrolled in classes via PowerSchool, as required under the Michigan Merit Curriculum (MMC) and according to their choice of elective(s).

 Our school follows a continuous school improvement planning process. We work to
 identify and close achievement gaps. We are implementing Multi-Tiered Systems of
 Support (MTSS) to provide for students' academic, behavioral, and social-emotional needs.
- 3. A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL Dollar Bay-Tamarack City Area Schools does not have a specialized school. CTE programs in various locations are available through the CCISD, as well as programs for those with severe mental, physical, or social-emotional needs. DB-TC is a single-building district including a K-5 elementary school, a 6-12 middle/high school, and a GSRP preschool. Special education/Resource room support is provided to our students with disabilities.
