## Welcome by FIWARE Foundation CEO Ulrich Ahle

1 Ulrich opened with an explanation of what topics the call would address and introduced FIWARE's newest Platinum Member **Red Hat**. He also stressed how FIWARE Foundation shares common goals and principles with NUMO (a MoU on data models are currently being drafted to be signed by both organizations) and how signing onto the Shared Mobility Principles for Livable Cities is a natural step.

## Fighting COVID-19: An overview of Opportunities

How can Open Source solutions fight Covid-19? Ulrich introduced EngDE4Bios and asked members to share related solutions/projects so that it can be included in the upcoming FIWARE4Health booklet. WeGo's upcoming webinar was also introduced.

## **Gold Members Contributions To Impact Stories And Use Cases**

Ulrich encourages members to get involved in Impact Stories and Use cases so that we can accelare the market adoption of FIWARE. Once ready, the catalogue of end users will be available to all and help members to promote their solutions.

## **Sneak Preview - Impact Story for AgriFood: Guest Speaker**

Andrea Cruciani first introduces TeamDev and Agriculous. Andrea then introduces the solution Agriculous in detail and how it is helping to deliver cost-efficient solutions towards precise farming. The solution has 3 main goals:

- 1) Reducing environmental impact.
- 2) Minimizing production costs for farmers.
- 3) Improving the quality of food.

Andrea stresses the importance of the FIWARE Ecosystem and encourages members to get in contact for potential partnerships.

## FIWARE Technical Roadmap: An Update

Junjo Hierro (FIWARE CTO) gives an overview of some recent technical activities. The next release is planned for September (to be announced during the Summit). It comes with a full fletch including Orion-LD (which will merge with Orion), Scorpio and Stellio (new Incubated FIWARE GE).

Smart Data Models: Initiative launched with TM Forum - initially for smart cities - and is now covering a wider rage of domains. Smart Water, Smart Destinations, Smart Industry are some examples. Juanjo also stressed that the Steering Committee meetings are open to all and new members can join, based on election, which is upcoming.

Tonia Sapia introduced the guest speaker (from EDI) and explained why this Open Call is so important. Diego López de Ipiña (Associate Professor, University of Deusto and
