

Nursery Teachers's Roles in Child Development

Who are nursery teachers? They are called early childhood educators or early childhood teachers **who inspire and encourage children in their education and development.** Unlike nursery nurses who care for small children, early childhood teachers are responsible for educating and nurturing children that are between 18 months to three years old. With the guidance from a nursery teacher, **the child is able to learn and grow his sensory abilities through the curriculum designed for them.**

And being able to feel these feeling for a child is also very crucial for them when they are young, knowing a place where they can feel safe even without their parents can help with their self-independent. How to create an environment that a child can feel safe not be easy without difficulties, as every child is different, the teacher is to observe and understand how the child needs or feels so they are able to make a plan or changes to let the child be more comfortable
