

QUAD BIKING

GENERAL INFORMATION

Push the limits and feel the force as you explore rough terrain on the back of a quad bike. These ultimate adventure vehicles allow both novice and experienced riders to explore the area at their own pace. Take in the panoramic views and possible wildlife sightings with friends and family under the supervision of a qualified guide. Our quad bike trips vary from bush track riding, whilst experiencing the local village life, to quad bike eco tours.

(BOTH OPTIONS)

- Minimum 2 pax – maximum 4 pax per trip
- Guests may get dirty in the rainy season
- Any clients suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed to do this activity
- The company currently operates Honda TRX 250cc four stroke quad bikes

WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING (BOTH OPTIONS)

- Camera
- Hat and sunglasses
- Sunscreen and mosquito repellent
- Non-slip closed shoes to protect the feet and enable the client to change gears with ease
- Warm jacket in winter
- Suitable outdoor clothing should worn. Skirts and dresses are not recommended

INCLUSIONS AND EXCLUSIONS (BOTH OPTIONS)

INCLUSIONS

- Transfers from hotels/lodges within Livingstone
- Training at the start of the activity
- Helmet which must be worn with the visor down at all times when riding
- Gloves in winter
- Soft drinks and water

EXCLUSIONS

- Anything that is not mentioned in the inclusions
- Visa Fees

CHILD POLICY

- Minimum age is 12 years for the Eco Tour and 16 years for the Village Trail

PICK UP AND DROP OFF TIMES

ECO TRAIL

PICK UP TIMES RUN FROM 08H00 - 15H00 DAILY

- Drop off at any lodge/hotel within Livingstone Town at approx. 1 hour after pickup time

VILLAGE TRAIL

- Drop off at any lodge/hotel within Livingstone Town at approx. 2 hours after pickup time
