We will be taking part in The Winter Film Festival hosted by Trauma Research Foundation Please join us during the first week of December as we join the line-up with some of the most important films in the field of trauma right now.

Each film explores a different aspect of how trauma can impact us. Combining cinema verité and investigative journalism, Medicating Normal follows the journeys of a newly married couple, a female combat veteran, a waitress and a teenager whose doctors prescribe psychiatric drugs for stress, trauma, mild depression, sleeplessness, and focus. As a result, they struggle with serious physical and mental side effects, and are saddled with neurological damage from taking the drugs as prescribed and from attempting to withdraw.

Following each film showing, there will be a live virtual Q&A session with key members of the film and the trauma community.
