


Embedding a Spotify Playlist

From the Dashboard, go to the Page or Post listing from either Page → All Pages or Posts → All Posts, placing the cursor over the page or post wanted and then clicking “Edit.”

After logging into Spotify, click the three dots next to the song, album, or artist, then hover mouse over “Share” and select “Copy Song Link” or “Copy Spotify URL” for the link to paste into WordPress.


A context menu is open over the "Share" option, showing the following actions:

 Spotify URL


