

Consistory Highlights March 10, 2026

Work has begun by the work of the newly formed Personnel Committee. This includes Job descriptions for staff, contact information and an organizational chart.

The budget for 2026 is nearing completion. Property Committee has numerous projects which need attention. The projects, prioritized in order of need to be done, will be presented, along with estimated costs, at the April meeting.

Transition to our new treasurer is completed. Our previous treasurer will manage pledging financial data.

Events Committee will be formed in order to handle requests for use of the sanctuary and porch for musical events. Request for our hosting a concert on May 9th has been received and is allowed as requested. It is not a precedent for the future. Logistics will be considered by the Events Committee.

Temporary location of the church office, in light of the structural damage caused by leaking roof was discussed.

Worship Committee will be offering a training for the combined role of greeter and usher on March 22.

The possibility of our church becoming involved in the Ulster Immigrant Defense Network was raised. It will be further considered in April. Deacons are making a \$500 contribution to this.
