Tournament Rules & Regulations

1. OKSE Handbook Reference

All non-game specific rules and regulations referenced in this document can be found in the OKSE High School Rules Handbook.

2. Game Classification

Marvel Rivals is classified as a **Virtual Title with Flex Scheduling Game** during the Spring 2026 Season of OKSE High School.

Important Notice

Virtual Title with Flex Scheduling Games cannot be played from home unless otherwise stated and approved. Reference Section 3 "Types of Tournaments" in the handbook for additional information.

3. Series Format

- **Regular Season:** Best of 3 (Maps/Modes)
- **State Playoffs:** Best of 5 (Maps/Modes) (Single Elimination)
- **State Championship:** Best of 5 (Maps/Modes) (No bracket reset)

4. Match Procedures

Start Times & Grace Period

Teams must start at the declared time. There will be a 10-minute grace period after the declared start time, after which the other team may request a forfeit.

Game Settings

If wrong settings, map types, or game modes are loaded while going into a map set, that map set must be restarted entirely. Previous map sets cannot be undone or replayed.

6. Lobby Settings

Room Configuration

- **Join Access:** Locked and Password Share
- **Spectator Access:** No spectating (external users), school live streaming is allowed to be in coach spot to view own team and other spectators can view school stream.
- **Ban/Pick Settings:** All matches in this Tournament follow a captain ban & lock process, which occurs as follows:
 - 1. Team A bans a hero;
 - 2. Team B bans a hero;
 - 3. Team B locks a hero;
 - 4. Team A locks a hero;
 - 5. Team A bans a hero;
 - 6. Team B bans a hero;
 - Locked heroes cannot be banned later

When making a custom game, utilize the **Tournament Room** tab. All official matches must use the **"TOURNAMENT"** tab for selecting maps and modes.

7. Coach Requirements

- Coaches must be present during matches
 - Coaches must be in the OKSE Discord server
 - Coaches must be verified adults
 - Coaches handle communication during disputes

Team Requirements & Restrictions

8. Team Composition

Player Requirements

- Teams consist of 6 players
- Minimum 5 players required to play (with coach agreement)
- Substitutions are only allowed before the match starts

9. Hero Restrictions

- New heroes banned for 2 weeks after release
- Heroes disabled in Ranked playlist are banned from competitive play
- Heroes may become available during playoffs if conditions are met

10. Disqualification Offenses

Zero Tolerance Policy

- T-Bagging
- Foul language of any kind
- Toxic chat (disrespectful, taunting, negative criticism)
- Hacking or game exploits

Proof required: Screenshot or video evidence must be provided to the executive board.

11. Eligible Platforms

 PC |  PLAYSTATION 5 |  XBOX SERIES S/X

Input Methods: Controllers on console, controllers or mouse/keyboard on PC

Additional Policies & Procedures

12. Stoppage of Play

Games may be paused for the following reasons:

- Player drops or disconnects
- Server crashes
- Technical issues with PC or hardware (coach verified)



Communication Protocol

The team's coach must be immediately notified of any issues. Coaches must communicate with each other during pauses via Discord text or voice chat.

13. Rescheduling Policy

If school is canceled for any reason (snow day, emergency, etc.), teams must reschedule within the same week. Failure to reschedule results in forfeit during makeup week.

14. Standings Determination

Weekly standings will be determined by:

1. Overall match record
2. Head-to-head results (if applicable)
