 - c) Chief executive officer Mark Brown reported that the rains have been welcome but much of it went to runoff, as we noticed around the Parkside.
 - d) Citizens Oversight Committee Recruitment is going well.

 - f) Finance report, we will be reimbursed for our projects when property tax revenues arrive in December
 - g) Fire Safe Marin reported that there were 30% more pickups for Chipper days this year. Also, red flag warning signs are available from Fire Safe Marin
