

How to View Answers for Checkups and Study Sheets

Answer Reveal is a feature that allows students to view answers and self-check their work for Study Sheets and Checkup activities.

- Study Sheets are worksheets that help students guide their learning and organize notes while working through online Study activities. Depending on a school's settings, students may or may not be able to view answers for Study Sheets.
- Checkups are activities that provide students with additional opportunities for unscored practice related to a lesson. Students can always view answers and self-check their work for these activities.

Important! Once triggered, Answer Reveal cannot be undone and the student will not be able to view or print a blank copy of the worksheet.

Answer Reveal is triggered by navigating to the last page of Study and Checkup activities. For this reason, worksheets should always be printed from the first page of the activity BEFORE navigating to the activity's subsequent pages.

If a student accidentally reveals answers, a teacher or mentor can print a blank copy from their version of the course.

How do students print blank worksheets and reveal answers?

Students must open the worksheet from either the first page of the activity or the course syllabus BEFORE navigating to the last page of the activity.

Answer Reveal is triggered by navigating to the last page of Study and Checkup activities. Once triggered, answers are displayed in the worksheet using red text.

A student accidentally revealed answers for a worksheet. What do I do?

A teacher or mentor can print a blank copy from their version of the course.
