The Texas French Symposium is our state French language and culture competition for students enrolled in grades 9-12 in a Texas school. If you are a new school interested in participating in this statewide French competition for **Texas high school students, grades 9-12**, welcome! If you have participated in the Texas French Symposium in the past but have not recently attended, we would love to have you join us again.

TFS 2027 will be held at **Lowery Freshman Center in Allen, TX on April 2 & 3, 2027**. The theme is *La Mode de la Francophonie: Les tendances vestimentaires des cultures francophones*.

Our History

The Texas French Symposium has been in existence for 63 consecutive years. With the goal of motivating French students to improve their oral and cultural competencies, our competition provides students an opportunity to compete in 24 categories, including written as well as oral events. There are also competition events in music, art, comic strip, and quiz bowl (Baccalauréat). We continue in that tradition this year on the beautiful campus of Lowery Freshman Center.

Please be aware that there have been recent changes to both the registration process and the specific events offered, so it will be important for you to access the 2027 forms and information available on our website.
