

Feature owners:

- Select a list of Moztrap tests (Smoketest, BFTs and other tests which need/worth automating) for automation
- Add the "need_automation" tag in the Moztrap test

Notes:

1. Tests to be automated: smoketests, BFTs, regressions, anything else the feature owners consider important
2. A preliminary selection of the main tests for automation should be finished by the end of Aurora week 3 - for features received while in Nightly - so that the automation team has enough time to develop and land the tests
3. More tests worth automating can also be tagged after that date
4. Features received later in the development process:
 - received in Aurora - list of tests to be available in Aurora week 6, when pre-beta sign-offs should be done
 - received in Beta - list of tests to be available as soon as the feature owner has the tests in Moztrap
5. If the test is available on multiple Firefox version, add the tag to all versions

Automation team:

- Get list of tests with "need_automation" tag
- Check existing coverage of those tests with all automation frameworks
- If test doesn't have automation coverage
 - Decide which tool should cover the test
 - *If the test needs Mozmill coverage*
 - Add "mozmill" tag for tests which need Mozmill coverage (restart, localization) (and notify Desktop Automation team in case they want to involve)
 - *If the test needs non-Mozmill coverage*
 - Log tracking bug for automated test creation (assign to self, CC Henrik and Anthony)
 - Create the automated test
- After the test is landed (or if it already has automation coverage)
 - Remove "need_automation" tag
 - Add "covered_by_automation" tag
 - Add link to the automated test that covers it in the "Description": e.g. covered by http://mxr.mozilla.org/mozilla-central/source/browser/components/customizableui/test/browser_914863_disabled_help_quit_buttons.js
 - Update automation coverage in tracking document
