No School for Students on Friday, October 14th

Just a reminder that there is no school for students on Friday, October 14th. I hope everyone enjoys the long weekend!

November 8th - Asynchronous Day for Preschool and Half-Day Kindergarten

November 8th is a staff professional development day where students do not attend school. As it was shared earlier this school year, due to the minimum school hour requirement, preschool and half-day kindergarten students will have asynchronous work on Tuesday, November 8th. This means that there will be some work that will need to be completed at home on this day. Your child's teacher will share this asynchronous work with students and parents no later than Monday, November 7th via their Google Classroom and / or other means of communication with parents.

November 8th - Day Off for Full-Day Kindergarten - 12th Grade

November 8th is a staff professional development day where students do not attend school. Unlike preschool and HDK, November 8th will be a typical non-school day for all students in Grs. FDK - 12. This means that there will be no work that is required to be completed at home on this day. We encourage students to make-up missing work, study for an upcoming test, work on a project, get organized, and/or practice their academic skills through various resources, but there will not be any required work and therefore there will be no graded work from this day.

Strategic Planning Parent Focus Groups - Save the Date


