The FCJ Governors are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people at every opportunity and expect all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.



- 1. Actions in the event of a Missing Child whilst on site:
- If a child cannot be found the Manager and Headteacher must be informed.
- A sweep will be carried out of the building and the outside area.
- If the child is not found, the Manager/Headteacher will contact the police with all of the child's details.
- Once the police have been informed the Operations Manager/Headteacher will inform the parents. The parent is to be given basic information about what has happened and advised to come to the Nursery.
- Child Care Registration will be informed.
- Once the child is found a full investigation will take place.
 - 2. Actions in the event of a Missing Child whilst off site:
- Head counts will take place regularly during an outing.
- If a child cannot be counted all the children will be brought together.
- One member of staff will check over the area.
- A member of staff with the children will contact the school and speak to either the Manager or Headteacher
- The Manager/Headteacher will contact the police with all the child's details.
- Once the police have been informed the Operations Manager/Headteacher will inform the parents. Parents are to be given basic information about what has happened and should be advised to come to the Nursery.
- Child Care Registration will be informed.
- A member of staff will go to the venue of the outing, to support staff with bringing the group of children back.
- One member of staff will stay at the venue until the police arrive.
- Once the child is found a full investigation will take place.
