



GENERAL RULES FOR SOLID ROCK MISSION VOLUNTEERS

The following information is provided to the applicant. Please read and keep it for future reference. All volunteers working with Solid Rock Mission (SRM) are required to abide by the following rules of engagement.

1. The volunteer agrees and accepts responsibility for adhering to the daily schedule at the mission.
2. Volunteers are obliged to obey and support the team leader(s) and follow the chain of command.
3. Volunteers must receive a blessing for missionary work from the ministers of the church where they serve and from their parents if they are under 18 years of age.
4. Volunteers should respect the upbringing, views and opinions of other team members.
5. Volunteers should be respectful of the people in the areas and the church where they will serve.
6. Volunteers should take care of all material, movable and immovable property of the mission.
7. Volunteers should limit the use of cell phones. Cell phone calls are allowed only during personal time.
8. Volunteers should dress decently (not vulgarly).
9. The following is prohibited between guys and girls: holding hands, giving each other massages, sitting on each other's laps, hugging, kissing, and having sexual relations. Also, at no time should guys and girls be left alone. Maintain respect in your relationships with the opposite sex. If you have strong intentions/desire to develop a relationship, tell the leader.
10. During the entire mission trip and during the volunteer's stay at the mission center, it is not allowed to listen to secular music or watch movies that are unacceptable in a Christian environment.
11. Behavior that is strictly prohibited;
 - a. swearing and profanity,
 - b. fighting and using physical force to resolve any dispute,
 - c. theft,
 - d. use of alcohol, tobacco products, electronic cigarettes and drugs,
 - e. irresponsible/illegal driving,
 - f. visit Internet sites containing erotic and pornographic materials,
 - g. name calling,
 - h. rudeness and use of physical force towards children and adolescents,
12. It is not allowed to post obscene photos on the Internet during the entire period of the missionary trip and during the volunteer's stay at the missionary center.
13. Volunteers are not allowed to spread false rumors and gossip about the mission.
14. In cases where there are violations of the rules of Christian morality and the Bible by a volunteer: debauchery, deception, theft, use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, drugs, as well as these rules, the administration reserves the right to remove such volunteers from volunteering in cooperation with Solid Rock Mission. The administration reserves the right to contact the volunteer's church leaders.
