

## SiSters 336 Collective FAQ's.

Our intention is always to foster a safe, respectful, and supportive space where our SiSters, friends and partners can share experiences, ask questions, and connect with one another. Enclosed are general questions with guidance and answers.

Who we are & Why we exist:

A. The SiSters 336 Collective is an advocacy group of women who offer supportive services, resources and leadership development on a voluntary basis with **no compensation**. As the visionary I took a leap of faith in starting this mission to help fulfill the gaps in available resource partners with a "**Village Mindset**" for the 336 communities as a whole.

Will you offer this opportunity for external cities and states as additional units or chapters?

A: As the organization grows and plants seeds it is our vision to establish units or chapters in other markets **by region** (Northeast, Southeast, Western, Central) around the world. Keeping the synergy growing as the seeds of the Village of SiSters blossoms.

Will you offer Youth and Adult Ambassador Opportunities?

A: In correlation with our **brand messaging** and outreach efforts to connect with the public community we will establish a platform program for the **SiSters 336 Collective Brand Ambassadors** for both our younger to older SiSters in the community. Representation is a key component and it is our purpose to ensure that we show up with an honor code to the premise of the collective organization.

How often will you meet?

A: Because we are newly established and building, our initial **onboarding and welcome address meeting will take place before the end of 2025**, that will outline clear expectations for those interested. Future meetings will be communicated during this session to take place after the new year. We will connect both virtually and in person with other organizations and leaders in areas beyond the 336 area to collectively evolve with the mission, fostering strong partnerships and sisterhood.

Membership dues: There is **no initial obligation** to any committee or advisory council membership dues as of right now. However as the organization grows over the next 6-12 months and into the new year there will be an annual membership fee of **\$75 required in June 2026**. T-shirt fees for community events will also be \$20 per individual. Annual commitment fees go to our programs, advocacy and outreach efforts. We are more than a collective showing up. At times we will need to provide resources that require monetary assistance and for that reason WE like to stay ready so that we don't have to get ready. Your annual investment is allocated based on the needs of the organization.

What are the benefits of joining the Collective? A: if you are someone who believes in advocating and supporting others, sisters women, etc the added benefits would be where you lean in and be a vessel of support. Your inner Shero prowess, your leadership skills, your voice

of advocacy and even a community connector across state lines are all valuable assets. My belief is that when one or two come together to help, the world is a much better place. But when a Powerful Collective of SiSters come together we can't be reckoned with.

Will there be any public facing participation requirements? A: YES!! As much as you are physically and mentally able, we are empowered when we **show up together as a unified collective** of Sisters who believes in the power of outreach, partnership and collaboration.
