The Trade Federation is the most important company operating within the Galaxy at this moment. Without the much needed hyperlanes that are maintained and owned by the Federation, many colonial planets and planets located far from the Core would face starvation. Due to the hung Senate, it is time for us to make our issues known to the Senate.

Our main issue will be the ownership of hyperlanes and how we can enforce our planetary contracts. It is important that we not only maintain our ownership of the hyperlanes, but that we are able to enforce our exclusive contracts with planets. Because of the need for low taxation with a strong senate, the Trade Federation has decided to back the Populist Faction for the time being - but is strictly neutral in matters related to trade.

Currently, we are looking to enforce an exclusive contract on the planet Nakadia which is rich in crops and plastics. Nakadia benefits from our hyperlanes and shipments to the planet, yet has not paid us a fair share of the profits. Therefore, the Trade Federation calls for the Senate to assist the Trade Federation. We will make the planet of Nakadia use only the Trade Federation for shipments and hyperlane travel. It is the Trade Federation which has found safe hyperlanes, and we will not allow the planet of Nakadia to send their agricultural shipments to other planets on our Hyperlanes until we are paid ₹15,000,000,000 in one lump sum for our damages and fees, with an additional ₹1,000,000,000 per year afterwards for one hundred years.

Additionally, we will call on the Senate to allow the Trade Federation to have additional security powers outside of the Core. The Trade Federation should legally have access to Destroyer-class ships, as well as a standing Security Force to patrol and protect the outer and mid rim from pirates and slavers.

The Trade Federation has nominated myself to be their representative within the Senate, and in Galactic-Political affairs. While I am aligned with the Populist caucus, I am open to creating alliances with other parties if it aligns with the interests of the Trade Federation. I have also decided to nominate myself to the position of Vice-Chair of the Senate, to provide a fair and balanced approach to Galactic Politics.
